Proceedings

Meeting called to order by Ben Goodman at 7:33pm. With a quorum of Directors being present, the meeting proceeded with business. At this time, a motion was made by Ross Gustafson to approve the January 11th, 2021 board meeting minutes. McCain Rosonke seconded the motion with no board members opposed.

COVID Update (Gustafson/Nathan)

- Encourage diligence on current COVID Return to Play Plan
- Update on cases/trends
 - No positive tests all negative thus far
 - Dakota county cases at 33 per 10,000 (14 day COVID-19 case rate)
- MDH/CDC Quarantine Guidance
 - o 10 days with no symptoms; 7 days with negative test

Program Updates

The Board received and discussed the following updates:

- In-house (Madden)
 - In-House continues to run the Skills Sessions at Highland; 2nd-6th Grade Sessions wrap up this Saturday. Players have really enjoyed being in the gym and working on their skills.
 - Kindergarten and 1st Grade sessions start the week of 2/20 and run for 3 weeks.
 - I have some extra shirts (black dri-fit with the Eastview logo on them), mostly Adult Medium.
 Anyone have interest in the shirts or know how we can repurpose them? Maybe save for future years as coaches/older players shirts? Try to sell them to make back the money?

 - Special thanks to Derek Bronson for helping get our teams all signed up for State!

Girls Tournament (Bronson)

- Girls Tourney 124 teams. Registration is closed. We're not accepting any more teams.
- Current gym space is AVCC and Burnsville High School. Need two more courts for Saturday to facilitate current teams registered. We have FRMS and SHMS but currently spectators not allowed.
- Prefer to not use courts where we cannot have spectators. Sara is going to talk with the district again, lay out our plan on how we will handle Covid mitigation. Hoping for 10 spectators per team but will be ok with fewer.
- Will reach out to Farmington or Lakeville this week if District wont flex on Spectators.
- o Tournament will be 3 consecutive games then move out with time based entry
- Each team provides scoreboard/bookeeper
- 8 team brackets will most likely stay as such, but a lot of divisions will be split into 4 team "safety pods". I'll explain more during the meeting.
- Recommend medals for all 1st, 2nd and 3rd...No shirts. Save money as we will have a lot more "brackets/divisions".
- o 350 DIBS outstanding to work the tournament
- Streaming service/Baller TV to be looked into by Nathan Scott
- Need volunteers to be Site Leaders (1 per location); ideally boys families need to handle
- o Determine whether a waiver needs to be completed or not; B. Goodman to follow-up
- Coach Development (McGrath)
 - Nothing new to report
- Player Development (M. Goodman / B. Walcker)
 - Shot club apparel has been handed out (except for 8B2 Spearman multiple email attempts and he hasn't picked up); photos posted on our website and social media

• Facilities (Hummel)

- SHMS and FRMS booked for Girls' Tournament no spectators allowed
