



Scholarship Policy & Application

PURPOSE: To establish a procedure under which those members and prospective members of the Vail Mountaineer Hockey Club (VMHC) desiring financial assistance may apply for scholarship subsidies.

POLICY: It shall be the policy of VMHC that, when available, scholarship funds will be accessible to those members of the association who demonstrate financial need. Such funds shall be available for an amount not to exceed 80% of the annual registration fees. It shall be understood by all applicants that upon approval of a scholarship request, applicant(s) will be expected to volunteer an additional 20 hours, above hours already required by all parents, for the benefit of VMHC. Approval responsibility for scholarship applications shall rest with the club's Treasurer and Scholarship Committee. The Treasurer will make a recommendation to the Board of Directors regarding the suitability of the scholarship request.

PROCEDURE:

1. Applicant(s) shall provide the VMHC Treasurer with a copy of the household's two most recent years' tax returns, including returns for both parents if they have filed separately.
