



UNIVERSITY OF SAN DIEGO PASSING TOURNAMENT RULE BOOK

- 1. Record is the #1 determination for seeding
 - a. For all tiebreakers: <u>HEAD TO HEAD RESULT</u> followed by <u>POINT DIFFERENTIAL</u> followed by <u>POINTS SCORED</u> will serve as the tie breaker for all seedings.
- 2. All games will be 20 minutes in length with a running clock. The clock will stop only when the tournament administrator believes that it is necessary to halt the field for at least one play.
- 3. There will be a coin toss or rock/paper/scissors at the beginning of each game. The winner of the coin toss chooses whether they start on Offense or Defense.
- 4. The field will be 40 yards in length, plus a 10-yard end zone, with all possessions starting at the 40-yard line. No matter where the defense stops the offense, the next possession begins at the 40.
- 5. Each team will have seven (7) live players on the field at all times (3-4 team just drop 7 defenders). So defenders must declare as rusher and take a knee before snap. The player that takes a knee **cannot** contact a player or interfere with QB throw. A shift/motion will allow the defense to change a player that has taken a knee. OLB can contact the TE one time, but must do so on the LOS. Contact must be below the neck. The player MAY NOT contact the TE then take a knee.
- 6. The offense has to have a player snap the ball from the ground to the QB to start play. A muffled snap continues play; QB can pick up the ball. The center cannot be eligible for a pass. The offense may deploy a total of five (5) receivers. There are no running plays. A double pass is NOT allowed, but passes MAY be completed behind the LOS. Shovel passes ARE permitted.
- 7. Only 1 offensive coach is permitted on the field, this includes the head coach. ALL other players and coaches must stay on the sideline. Substitutions must be made from the sideline. No defensive coaches are allowed on the field. Coaches are not permitted on the field of play and no coach is allowed to stand behind or in the end zone. A player is allowed to stand with the offensive coach and chart plays.
 - a. MORE than 1 coach being on the field results in a 10-yard penalty.
- 8. The QB has 4 seconds to release the ball. If the ball is not thrown in that time, the play is blown dead and the ball will return to the LOS for the next down. The count will be kept by the tournament administrators.
- 9. One first down may be achieved per offensive possession. A first down is earned by reaching the 20-yard line within four downs. After converting a first down, the offense will have four plays to score, all of which can initiate eight total plays within a series.
- 10. A touchdown scores six (6) points. The offense may choose to go for a one-point conversion from the five-yard line or two points from the 10-yard line. There are no field goals or PAT kicks. Score will be kept by the tournament administrator assigned to each field.
- 11. Defensive Scoring: Interception is worth four points. Once the ball is intercepted, the ball will be marked down and possession changes. There are no defensive touchdowns. No points will be awarded to the defense on conversion attempts.
- 12. On a fumble the ball is dead when it hits the ground, offense retains possession. The ball carrier is down when touched by one hand of the defender. You may not leave your feet to make a tackle. No Diving. There is no rushing the QB.
- 13. There will be no blocking (hands extended in the attempt to block a defender), however shielding will be permitted.
- 14. All penalties will be 5 yards or 1/2 the distance (Decline Option). Replay all downs with the following exceptions:
 - a. Offense: unsportsmanlike penalties will result in a loss of down. Defensive unsportsmanlike penalties will result in an automatic first down.
 - b. A flagrant penalty will result in an ejection for the rest of the tournament.
- 15. Offense has 30 seconds to put the ball in play or receive a 5-yard delay of game penalty. A play in progress during the final whistle will be completed. The game cannot end on a defensive penalty, unless the offense declines it. Regular substitution rules apply.
- 16. "Last Attack"
 - a. If a team has possession of the ball (2 or more plays into the drive) and the clock has expired, the team with possession will be allowed to finish their drive
- 17. Overtime Rules: There will be one play sudden death. The team that wins the flip chooses offense or defense. The ball is then placed on the yard and there is one play sudden death. The offense wins by scoring the play, the defense wins by getting a stop.


CAMPUS MAP
