Re: COVID 19 Impacts and Sudbury Swim and Tennis in 2020

Dear SS&T Club Members,

I am writing to let you know that, due to the continuing uncertainty over the impacts of COVID 19, we are delaying registration for swim programs and tennis programs until early May, when we will have greater certainty about how the 2020 season will proceed. **The Board's priority in decisions about the 2020 season is the health and safety of our members and our employees.**

As you are aware, the Governor has temporarily closed health clubs while the COVID 19 virus is reaching its peak impacts. We remain hopeful that COVID 19 will run its course and health clubs will be able to be reopened prior to the start of the SS&T 2020 season. Publicly reported expectations for Massachusetts indicate the virus may peak around mid-April and diminish significantly thereafter. This is a rapidly changing situation and the Club's Board of Directors has been actively monitoring events and developing plans for the multiple contingency situations which might have an impact on the Club's normal operations for the 2020 season.

We expect to provide further information regarding 2020 plans around the beginning of May or as current State restrictions are revised or removed. Members will be updated when changes occur and further decisions are made by the Board. I, along with the Board of Directors, appreciate your patience during this time.
