Tournament Rules for 18th Annual Thanksgiving Tournament - November 2021

- 1. All teams must be USA Hockey sanctioned.
- 2. The USA Hockey Zero Tolerance Policy will be enforced.
- 3. Teams are expected to exhibit complete sportsmanship, playing each game to the best of their ability.
- 4. All players must wear proper equipment in accordance with USA Hockey.
- 5. The tournament will furnish all timekeepers and scorekeepers for all games.
- 6. Injured players on the bench must wear team jerseys and helmets.
- 7. Game officials will be members of the RI Hockey Referees Association.
- 8. All games will have a 3-minute warm-up period prior to their start.
- 9. Squirts, Peewees and Bantam will consist of three twelve-minute stop time periods.
- 10. At the start of, or any time during the third (3rd) period, if a 6-goal differential exists, then running time shall commence and shall revert back to stop time if the difference becomes less than 6 goals.
- 11. No time-outs allowed during preliminary games.
- 12. One time-out is allowed during championship games only. The one time-out can be used during regulation time or during overtime (not both).
- 13. Each team will play a minimum of 3 games.
- 14. Penalties: Squirt, Peewee and Bantam minor = 1 1/2 minutes. Major = Squirts and Peewee 4

 $minutes, \ Misconduct = 6 \ minutes, \ Fighting \ Penalty = Tournament \ Disqualification, \ Four \ penalties = out \ of \ current \ and \ next \ game.$

- 15. There will be no overtimes, except championship games.
- 16. Defaulted games, if any, will result in the awarding of a 3-0 win over the opponent of the defaulting team.
- 17. Determining ties in standings in advancing to championship games: a) Most points Win=2 points,

Tie=1 points, Loss=0 points b) Best record against opponent involved in tie c) Least goals allowed d) Least penalty minutes e) Most Goals for f) Coin toss.

- * in the event of a three-way tie in points (a), in which all tied teams have not played each other, or there is no obvious head-to-head winner, per USA Hockey rules, the tie breaker would proceed to the next step least goals allowed (c)
- 18. Determining winners in championship games in case of ties: a) Five minute sudden-death overtime

period 5 vs 5, if no winner then sudden death 4 vs 4, then sudden death 3 vs 3 until a goal is scored.

- 19. Handshakes at the end of the games shall occur at the discretion of the referee.
- 20. Any game ejection consists of missing next tournament game, there are no appeals, and all referee decisions are final.
- 21. ALL TEAMS MUST BE READY 15 MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULED START TIME...IF TIME PERMITS, WE WILL START GAME EARLY
