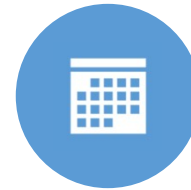

Parent Code of Conduct



- First and foremost, be positive and have fun!
- Lead by example before, during, and after each team function.
- Help provide a safe playing environment for your players.
- Do not, at any time, use foul or inappropriate language while representing your team or EYBSA
- Place the emotional and physical well-being of your players ahead of everything else.
- Accept the decisions of the officials without exhibiting inappropriate behavior.
- **Never argue or discuss a rule or decision with an umpire. This is the Head Coach's job only.**
- Treat all coaches, umpires, opponents, players, and other parents with the utmost respect and dignity always.
- Provide an environment for your team that is free of drugs, alcohol, tobacco and e-cigs; abstain from their use during any team activity.
- Respect the game. Be knowledgeable in both the NFHS Baseball, USA Softball, JBO and CCGSA rulebooks; abide by them and teach them to your player(s).

Rookies & T-Ball



T-Ball

- Practices start after spring break
- Practices two days per week
- Season typically ends the first weekend in June
- Games on Saturdays, opportunities for coaches to schedule optional weekday games
- Players will receive a hat and jersey
- Baseball pants and cleats optional, shorts and tennis shoes are ok
- Required gear; helmet, bat and glove

Rookies

- Practices start after spring break
- Practices two days per week
- Season ends with the end of season tournament, June 11&12
- Games start towards the end of April
- One weekday game and one Saturday game each week
- Players will receive a jersey, hat, game pants, socks and a belt
- Gear needed; a helmet, bat, protective cup, glove and cleats

Practice & Games



Softball

- Practices start after spring break
- Coaches may setup optional practices before and during spring break
- Typically, 2-3 practice days per week – coach sets schedule
- Season typically ends the first weekend in June
- Games twice a week (M/W or T/Th)
- 10u-14u EYBSA Tournament May 13-15
- Possible memorial weekend tournament
- CCGSA End of Season Tournament week of 6/10
- Players will receive a hat and two jerseys (home & away)
- Pants (black), socks (forest green), and belt (forest green) must be purchased by parent/player
- Required gear; cleats, batting helmet with facemask, bat, glove, and defensive facemask (mandatory for pitchers)
- **New softball players must submit raised seal birth certificate to eybsajbo@gmail.com**

Levels of Play: JBO Baseball



- Junior Baseball Organization (JBO)
- EYBSA is required to follow JBO's matrix on right
- Generally, the National level is for players with beginning or recreation level skills, the American level is for intermediate skills, and the Federal level is for players with the highest skill level.
- Softball is still undecided the competition levels for the 2022 season
