As expected, Baseball Canada cancelled their National and Western championships and then Baseball BC did the same with the Pathway tournaments to said Championships which leaves our "Provincials" for championship play. Without a comprehensive spring season, I hesitate to call them "Provincials" but time will tell.

Single season schedules have been revised for June 1 or July 1 starts and some consideration has been given to running a John Main in the Fall.

Recent messaging has given "hope" to return to play options and guidelines have been discussed at all levels so to assist in understanding what BCMBA may be expected to do and what we should expect BCMBA prepared and sent out a survey last week which has returned much of what we expected.
