3. How are practices, game schedules, and tournament schedules distributed?

A) Fall "Ball" League Practice and Game Schedules

All practice times and locations will be located under the "Fall League" tab on the Hoops website. Once teams are decided, the team rosters will also be posted on this same page. In the event of bad weather, or changes to the schedule, the schedule will be updated on the Hoops page, and an email and Facebook "Hoops" message will be sent out. Please check the website for the most up to date information.

B) Traveling Teams – Practice schedules will be posted to sportsengine. Once your son is placed on a team, your sportsengine login email will be connected to your son's team utilizing the sportsengine app, and you'll get your traveling league practice schedule and location updates through the SportsEngine app.

Tournament schedules are typically sent out the week of the tournament (generally Mon/Tues) and will be sent to the teams as soon as they are received.

Each respective team's coach will also have access to that specific team, and will communicate any required correspondence through the SportsEngine app.

4. Will there be a block reserved for hotel rooms for Tournaments?

Please do NOT expect blocks of hotel rooms reserved for any award tournaments by Hoops. Please DO expect to have open communication on where families are booking hotel accommodations – this can be facilitated by parents if needed and can be done either outside of the SportsEngine app or with the SportsEngine app as that specific team sees fit.

What's a Board Member Rep?

You may have noticed there is a Board Member Rep (Representative) listed under the Staff section of your team (posted on the Marshall Hoops website). Although we do our best to ensure the season runs smoothly, we do realize that questions or concerns may come up. As such, each team is assigned a Board Member Representative and we ask you to please contact your assigned Board Member Rep with any concerns. ***Please refrain from contacting Coaches directly and utilize your designated Board Member Rep***

5. How can I volunteer to help the Hoops Club?

<u>Purchase Marshall Hoops Basketball Apparel</u> - Links to purchase apparel will be sent out via email and listed on the website once available. This is a great way to support the team and could make a nice holiday gift!

The businesses will get their names listed on the team's shooting shirts and name recognition when the team is mentioned in the Marshall Independent.

Marshall Hoops Club Home Tournament – The Marshall Hoops Basketball is scheduled for February 21st and 22nd this season, and we'll need volunteers to help make this tournament a success! Both parents will be asked to volunteer their time (either working in the concessions or admission table) and provide a dozen bars/cookies to be sold at the concession stand. The volunteer schedule is generally sent out the week of the tournament and we'll ask you to find a replacement if the time assigned doesn't work (we do our best to schedule volunteer hours so you can watch your child play

- i.e. if your child plays on Saturday, your volunteer hours will likely be scheduled for Sunday).

SportsEngine - FAQ



How do I join a team? Once your child is registered for a team and you're signed into the App under the sign in that you registered your child, the team should show up under 'My Teams' section. You can 'Add Team' and search accordingly but note that if you add the team as a fan, you will not have access to the team chat.


How to Add Guardians

NOTE: Guardians do not receive text message notifications on behalf of the player profile.

Family members of an athlete can be added as "Guardians" to view the team schedule, RSVP to games and events, message team members, and edit the athlete's profile.

- 1. Sign in and go to the Household tab of your dashboard.
- 2. On an athlete sub-profile, click View Profile.
 - NOTE: You can not add a Guardian to the account owner's profile.
 - If you don't have a sub-profile for the athlete, you must add one through registration or by claiming a roster spot.



3. On the right side, under the *Guardians* header, click the **plus sign(+)**.

- 4. Input the Guardian's email address to invite them.
- 5. Toggle which athlete profiles this Guardian should manage.
