What is WEHL?

Tier II Before (14U) or Before and After (16U) Program

Program Overview

The goal of WEHL is to better prepare players for their upcoming association & WIAA high school season by providing challenging practices and competitive games in a

format that compliments other fall sports.

This goal is in conjunction with the goal of building a bigger pathway for development that provides more female players opportunities. All participants must be a resident of WI or attend a WI High School.



Key Points

Registration is open from June 1st to July 1st. This is a firm cut off date to assess if a division will run.

- If the required minimum registration number of 17 is not met for a division, that division will be dissolved.
- Tryouts, if Required, will be held between July 28th and August 15th in all Regions. Locations and times will be posted by June 15th on the WEHL Website <https://www.wi-ehl.net/>
- All players trying out who do not make the teams can attend practices (\$100 Registration fee covers all practices)
- Just as WEHL has been a conduit for which the male players can develop and be seen by the TW program, so will be the goal for Girls WEHL players.
- 14U Plan: 1 x practice per week, 8-10 games (combination of 1 tournament, 2 festivals and independently scheduled games) ends mid October
- 16U Plan: 1 x practice per week, 14-16 games, (combination of 2 tournaments, 2 festivals and independently scheduled games) Fall session ends late October, resumes for Season play in March.
- Refunds will only be issued if a division is dissolved due to insufficient registrants
- \$425.00 for the 14U's and \$550.00 for the 16U's (registration fee applied to this cost). Includes Jerseys and socks
- 6 practices @ 75 minutes each
- Great coaching focused on development and engagement
