- Each school can run a maximum of 10 competitors per age class. Please submit your team by **Monday**, **October 4th AT THE LATEST**. By Friday, October 1st would be even better but with everything in flux, we will try to accommodate.

 - o Please indicate if your Intermediate runners are in grade 8 or 9.
 - NAME TAGS WILL BE PROVIDED
- There will be a medal for the top finisher in each age division and ribbons from 2nd to 10th. These items will be handed out at the end of the meet.
- It is unlikely we will have a concession given the quick turn-around on this. Water and a granola bar/treat will be available at the finish line for the runners.
- We will have two porta-potties brought down to the start line area. There are no change rooms available, so runners should come changed and ready to run!
- Each athlete will get water and a treat at the end of their race.
- **The Provincial Team** will be picked that day. All Intermediate, Junior, and Senior competitors must commit at the finish line. Intermediate competitors MUST BE IN GRADE 9 to advance to Provincials.
- There will be a coaches' meeting immediately following the meet to confirm Provincial details and assign numbers for the athletes.
- Provincials are being held in Humbolt this year on Saturday, October 16th.
- While many ran our new course last week, just a reminder of some of its challenges:
 - There is a long down-hill section of loose gravel where footing can be tricky.
 Please check your speed and safety.
 - o There is some river rock on this path that we have attempted to push aside, but it can still be treacherous if athletes are not paying attention to footing.
 - This is a beautiful course, but the footing requires attention as it takes place on paths through wooded areas and along the Trans Canada Trail; there are a few areas where the soil has been run-off. We are going to try to fix this before, but just in case, be aware.
 - The paths are subject to weathering, especially downed leaves that can be slippery or hide hazards like gopher holes. We have attempted to locate and flag or mark major points for students to watch, but Mother Nature tends to offer some surprises!
 - The large, long uphill is paved (but runners can run to the side on grass) and they
 do have to cross the paved path leading to the Sky Trail so cleats might be
 damaged.
