- Presented December minutes, which were sent in advance through USAW Membership website to review and provide updates
- Motion to accept minutes by Roby Webster
- Jeanne Whetstone seconded the motion.
- Motion passed unanimously

Treasurer: Jeff Strueder

- Financial documents were loaded to USAW library for review prior to meeting.
- Shared reports online.
- CDs finally closed with FCSC. Provided balances.
- Our position is improving.
- Budget vs actuals. Memberships, sanctions, charters, and donations showing as income
- Donations \$2,000 from Coaches' Association; Restricted donation from the Dowdens.
- Equipment sales, Sponsorship T-shirt, hard cards, leader memberships also showing. Currently at 70% of budgeted.
- \$220 streaming proceeds from Flo.
- Pat Culp has emailed Flo twice, to determine what this \$220 is (believed to be streaming proceeds).
- \$28,000 income for Elementary State.
- Middle school duals \$15000 income.
- Women's' Folkstyle Nationals expenses showing.
- Coaches' Association Banquet went up to \$30. We are in line for this expense.
- John Hurrle award added to expenses.
- Some cords were purchased and put into tournament budget.
- Cleared about \$14,000 on the event Elementary State Duals.
- Middle School State Duals cleared about \$5,000 on this tournament.
- Financial review completed by accountant. Will receive an accounting bill soon for clean-up. Jeanne Whetstone made a motion to accept the treasurer's report
- Jennifer Pierson seconded the motion
- Motion passes unanimously.

New Business

Folkstyle State

- Jennifer Pierson reported the tournament committee has met several times.
- There is a walkthrough Thursday afternoon and then will have a follow up tournament meeting.
- Roby Webster said we will probably change location of weigh ins and door numbers. Will communicate that once it is finalized.
- Will have 25 mats inside of one location, 2 additional mats in the south gym, 14 in fieldhouse, 6 in south gym, 3 in west cafeteria, 2 in east cafeteria.
- Roby Webster will be reaching out with schedule for volunteers.
- Jonah Odum has been talking with 3X about Championship t-shirts.
- We did not have enough larger sizes like 2x and XL last year.
- Pat Culp said that she thinks there were T-shirts taken to the other facility. She thought we were going to use the girls' as a separate color. Jonah Odum will make sure this happens.

Meeting with Dave Matthews

- Jen Ratliff, Jennifer Pierson, Pat Culp met with him.
- We are doing things a little different for our state tournaments.
- Will not be using Trackwrestling for registration.
- We will use USA Wrestling membership site. They will register under their profile.
- Dave Matthews has basically built our ranking system.
- We will no longer be using separation.
- Christina from USA Wrestling for the ranking system and how to register for folkstyle state.
- Trackwrestling scales we can now use regular scales and use the scanner to scan their card and it will come up on the computer. It will show red or green, based on whether they made weight.
- Weigh ins will be done through USA and then will be imported into Trackwrestling.
- Jim Littlejohn said there are several officials who are already versed in it from working pre-season nationals.
- Rankings is based upon the athlete's card number, so they will not be able to delete tournaments or change things.
- There are only 2 other states using.
- Roby Webster asked about the phones not always working with the scanner. Pat Culp said that we will be able to scan for coaches' bands as well. She is having Dave Mathews place the code of conduct into the system.

WIN magazine

- Pat Culp said she was contacted by WIN magazine and Illinois.
- If a state would pay \$1 per athlete, they would actually mail to each individual who signed up for the magazine (they currently receive a digital copy). We would have to pay them \$1 per athlete and we would get back \$10 per magazine.
- We are ranked 5th in the nation at number of wrestlers. After discussing, we will not be taking them up on this.

- Leaving work early to go to Hobart HS to witness this non ISWA sanction State Folkstyle qualifier for finals at Brownsburg High School. This is a very small tourney on paper. 80 grammar school kids started at 9am CST and 60 middle school kids start at 1 pm CST. I read that the top 5 qualify
- Will give Pat an update later (see below)
- Update on Hobart kids grades 1-6 qualifier for their state championship
- As you may be aware the Frosh Soph High school State championship qualifier for women and men is going on at the same time in the same fieldhouse.
- There are two state qualifiers in the state, Hobart and Evansville.
- This is a huge event. Some 675 wrestlers from the north and Central Indiana. Saw that Indianapolis High Schools are here too. This tournament takes up 90% of the fieldhouse.
- The grade schoolers take 2 mats. It's a very small tournament. The predominant clubs are Bulldog, Midwest Xtreme, Elite Wrestling Academy, and Region Wrestling.
- Brackets are small and wrestlers and parents are packed in at end of fieldhouse. We call it organized chaos.
- Hobart staff are very busy either playing refs
- I'm assuming this Frosh-Soph qualifier is ran by the IHSCWA.

- You can only enter with the club they are registered with. Working with Christina at USA to get all that were entered into open to move to Team Indiana.
- Heartland Duals Doug Strayer will be team leader.

- \$300 for package.

- Shouldn't lose money this year based on expenses.
- 723 card carrying members of women at this time, 11th in the nation.
- Would like to make a proposal for parents who get gear for folkstyle nationals, and goes on junior duals – would like to discount \$225 if they are going on another trip with the same gear. This would help unity and would get parents to send their girls on more trips.
- Jonah believes that we gave them \$25-\$50 discount will have to double check.
