There are unique characters on this team that can compete like no other, and have the ability to make you laugh. These Seniors will be greatly missed.

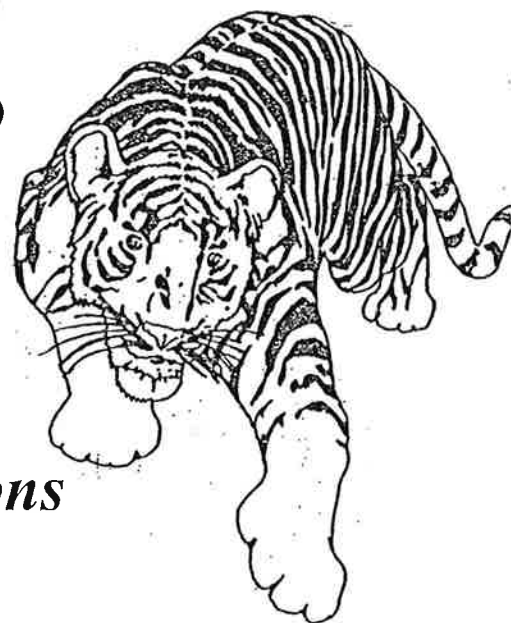


