## 2023 AAA State Rules

The 2023 AAA State Tournament will follow USA Hockey rules with noted exceptions:

- 14 min stop time periods, no resurfaces.
- Running time with 5 goal-margin at any time.
- No timeouts in pool play.
- All minor penalties will be 2:00.
- No checking, except 2010's.
- Touch up offsides.
- No icing the puck while short-handed.
- Fighting, racial slurs, \& homophobic slurs will result in Tournament Disqualification.


## Preliminary Round

- Scoring: Regulation Win=3 points. Overtime/Shootout Win=2 points. Overtime/Shootout Loss=1 point. Regulation Loss=0 points.
- In case of a tie there will be one 3-minute running time, 3-on-3 sudden-death period. If still tied, there will be a one-player shootout. Teams must exhaust all eligible players on their roster before repeating any shooter.


## Tie Breaker

Teams are ranked based on points earned during preliminary round. In case of a tie between 2 or more teams, these tiebreakers will be used in this order:

- Head to head winner (2-team tie only)
- Goals allowed
- Goal differential (max of 5 goals per game)
- Goals scored
- Team with fewest penalty minutes
- Coin flip (done by director with both coaches present)


## Playoff Round:

- 2010: Top 2 teams by points will advance to play for the Championship. The two teams with the next highest points will advance to 3 rd place game. The two teams with the highest points will play in the $5^{\text {th }}$ place game.
- 2011: Top 2 teams by points will advance to play for the Championship. The two teams with the next highest points will advance to 3 rd place game.
- 2012: Top 2 teams by points will advance to play for the Championship. The two teams with the next highest points will advance to 3 rd place game. The two teams with the highest points will play in the $5{ }^{\text {th }}$ place game.
- 2013: Top 2 teams by points will advance to play for the Championship. The two teams with the next highest points will advance to 3 rd place game.
- Overtime rules for Championship Games.
- 1-minute rest period
- First overtime is played 4-on-4 with a 3:00 minute running time period.
- If a tie remains, a second overtime is played 3-on-3 with a 3:00 minute running time period.
- If a tie remains, a third overtime is played 2-on-2 with a 3:00 minute running time period.
- If no winner in OT, there will be a one player sudden victory shootout. Every rostered skater must shoot before a player on the team shoots twice.
- Overtimes rules for $\mathbf{3}^{\text {rd }} \& 5^{\text {th }}$ Place Games.
- In case of a tie there will be one 3-minute running time, 3-on-3 sudden-death period. If still tied, there will be a one-player shootout. Teams must exhaust all eligible players on their roster before repeating any shooter.


## Conduct

All players, coaches \& spectators are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship. Anyone disrespectful to tournament officials, volunteers, referees, and/or the other team WILL NOT be warned, they will be asked to leave. The sole purpose of this event is to give great teams a chance to play against other great teams in one venue. Any disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
