

Johnson Recreation Uniform & Volunteer Agreement

Uniform Policy:

The player and his/her parent(s)/guardian agree to accept a Johnson Recreation uniform for use during season with the understanding that they are responsible for proper use, laundering, and the return of the uniform at the end of the season.

The player and his/her parent(s)/guardian agree to pay a replacement fee for any uniform that is damaged or not returned. Reasonable wear on the uniform is not considered damage. I understand the uniform is to be returned within 7 days of the conclusion of the season. I understand that I am responsible for the specific items issued to me identified by the number located somewhere on the uniform (usually either the item size tag or the jersey number). Players who leave during the season are required to return their uniform in within 5 days of the first missed practice, failure to do so will result in the uniform deposit being cashed.

I understand a refundable \$50.00 deposit will be due when the uniform is assigned, payable by a check separate from any other fees, the check will be held until the uniform is returned in acceptable condition within 7 days of the conclusion of the season. If the uniform is not returned, or is in unacceptable condition when returned, I understand and agree that the deposit will not be returned, and the check will be deposited for a replacement uniform. Uniform deposit checks will be returned within 14-21 days of the conclusion of the season if a self-addressed stamped envelope is provided; otherwise they will be voided and shredded.

The issued uniform pieces are to only be worn by athletes for scheduled games or for other special events as requested by the coach. Do not wear uniforms as regular clothing, or to practice. Do not loan to any other player, the responsibility for the uniform lies entirely with the player and the parent(s).

Volunteer Requirement Policy:

If you choose to volunteer time to reduce the cost of your registration fee and do not fulfill the requirement the uniform deposit will not be returned to you.

Uniform Laundry Instructions

Laundrying improperly can cause the screen-printing and/or iron-on lettering to crack and peel. Proper laundrying will allow the uniforms to last many seasons.

General Uniform Care Instructions:

Uniform Do's

DO - Use mild detergent.

DO - Launder soiled garments immediately according to care labels. If immediate laundrying is not possible, hang soiled garments on plastic or wooden hangers so they are not piled damp.

DO - Wash garments inside out and allow to air dry.

DO - Follow care labels provided in garments.

DO - Store garments in a cool, dry area protected from sunlight and fluorescent light to prevent mildew or yellowing.

Uniform Do not's

DON'T - Launder in water hotter than 110 degrees. These conditions can release dyes.

DON'T - Wash colors with whites.

DON'T - Bleach.

DON'T - Pile or bag soiled or damp garments together. This can cause staining from the dyes and possibly cause permanent damage.

DON'T - Allow garments to remain in the washing machine after cycle has finished. This can allow colors to bleed.

DON'T - Dry garments in the dryer

DON'T - Iron or press garments.

DON'T - Wash with zippered garments or anything that can sag and pull the uniform material.
