- a. Approval of minutes for the board of directors meeting from July 6, 2020 (August 3rd, 2020 meeting cancelled; no quorum) - Secretary

II. NEW BUSINESS

a. President

i. Homeless

- 1. Per River Rd/Corydon Neighborhood Meeting; HOPE squad officers visit Butterfield about 2-3x per week. Approximately 20 homeless live in the Butterfield area. No new vagrants. CPD cannot do anything about the homeless. 15 tickets need to be issued in order for one to get arrested (take them down to the station; misdemeanor; jailed, released, lather rinse repeat). CPD cannot keep homeless due to lack of shelter beds in Corona.. Someone is hunting the boars with a knife and selling the meat to other homeless people. Keep an eye on a white van with Texas plates. Unsettling behavior towards softball players.
- 2. We have to be calling the non-emergency Corona PD on the homeless doing suspicious activity. Be the squeaky wheel.
- 3. Spring season; to include in managers packet to call non-emergency CPD for homeless for any suspicious activity.

 - v. 60th Anniversary Promos
 1. \$160 registration fee (8U and up); \$60 off for the month of October for early bird discount. Payment plan (oct, nov, dec).
 - a. Ariel: motion to commemorate \$60 off for early bird discount to expire after 14 days start day after registration opens; October 15-31st.
 - b. 2nd = KN, yes = 9, no = 1
 2. Jana: TBall = \$60 registration fee. If moving up, the player's parent(s)/guardian will need to pay the difference. Promo for first two weeks only.
 - a. 2nd: DG
 - b. Yes: 9, no = 1
 3. \$30 buyout will be per player and not by family if we lower it to \$60.
 4. Sal & Mike suggest not to charge less for registration because it may cause confusion for following seasons.
- c. Equipment/Field Maintenance Coordinator
- i. Maintenance on SmithCo: \$3,000 to repair.
 - ii. Distribution System needed for: Keys, gear, thermometers, etc.
 - iii. In July/August, field 5 baseball cut locks; pvc pipe bat racks were busted.
 - iv. Replace missing bat holders
 - v. Replace home plate: need two more home plates. Field 5 is broken
 - vi. Need sprayer to sanitize bathrooms.
 - vii. Will wait until after the presidential election to assess these purchases. (BHS)
- d. Sponsors
- i. JL & JS to send out letters to get sponsors. All in attendance agree to send out letters. Hemborg Ford always donates. For future reference, consult sponsors if they'd like to receive their sponsor checks back should a cancelled season to ever happen again. Some sponsors were not pleased receiving their check back.
