- The 7th 9th place teams from Select will move down to Championship
- The 1st place teams from Championship will move up to Select
- The 7th 9th place team from Championship will move down to Trillium White
- The 1st place teams from Trillium White will move up to Championship
- The 7th 9th place team from Trillium White will move down to Trillium Green
- The 1st place teams from Trillium Green will move up to Trillium White
- Note: The balance of teams moving up and down or the number of teams in each division will depend on the number of registrations received and exemptions granted for the next event.
