Program Updates

The Board received the following updates:

General (All)

- o EVBA's return to play plan updated based on MDH current guidance
- O At this time, a motion was made by Michelle Goodman to provide a prorated refund for 2 boys players that have been injured for the majority of the season. Ross Gustafson seconded the motion with no board members opposed. John Grosse will determine the final refund amounts based on practice and tournament participation similar to refund approach for last year's COVID impact. Gustafson to provide updated bylaw language for these situations.

In-House (Madden)

- o 3rd-6th grade In-House season is coming up on the last few weeks
 - SSYBL tournament will be held the weekend of Feb. 25 and 26
 - Will compile list of suggestions from coaches
- o K-2nd Grade will wrap up their Skill Session on 2/26
 - Will try to get some feedback from parents on how this year's coaches have done; positive thus far
- o In-House will need to look at getting some new basketballs (size 27.5) for next year. Each In-House 3rd and 4th Grade team has a ball bag with 2-3 balls in it. The rest of the balls are at Oak Ridge and Diamond path as extras for practices. While some of our players bring their own balls, many use the balls we provide and our K-2nd Grade Skills Sessions are short on good quality 27.5 balls. Will work with Kris to order new balls.

- o Blue above .500, Silver at .500 and White/Gold below .500 win percentages
