If a student is already struggling with grades, or is involved in several other programs, please think hard about this decision. This is a team sport where each individual plays a very important role. The inability of one individual to balance their commitments affects the whole team.

All paperwork included in this packet is due at tryouts on **4/23 at 4:30pm**. Please also be sure to complete the online tryout application, linked on our website, by **4/22 at 4:30pm**. If you do not have your paperwork, you will not be permitted to try out and therefore will not be placed on a team.

# WHS CHEETZ TIZYOUT INFOTZMATION

### **Squads Available:**

Varsity JV (Sideline only)

#### **Eligibility for Squads:**

- Candidates must be entering grades 7-12
- Candidates must live in WHS boundaries or attend WHS
- Candidates must fill out the online application form by 4:30pm the night before tryouts, April 22 (link available at whsactivities.org cheerleading page, tryouts tab)
- Candidates and at least one parent/guardian must sign an informed consent form and code of conduct form stating that they agree to and are aware of the risks, policies, expense, expectations, commitment and responsibility required and expected from team members (included below)
- All athletes must be in good academic standing to try out and maintain good academic standing to maintain their status on the team

#### Paperwork Required.

- A completed Informed Consent and Permission form with parent and athlete signatures must be turned in before you will be allowed to participate in any clinic activity (this must be printed and brought with you to tryouts).
- A completed Code of Conduct form with parent and athlete signatures must be turned in prior to clinic participation (this must be printed and brought with you to tryouts).
- A completed Rules and Policies Agreement with parent and athlete signatures must be turned in prior to clinic participation (this must be printed and brought with you to tryouts and can be found on page 21 of the WHS Cheerleading handbook)
- A printed copy of a current grade report must be submitted on tryout day. Screenshots will be accepted.
- In addition to a current grade report, students currently in grades 9-11 will be required to submit an unofficial transcript.
- After tryouts, an academic status check will be performed before full acceptance on the squad.
  - o All team members are expected to maintain at least a 2.0 GPA throughout the season.
  - O Team members must maintain passing grades in **ALL** courses in order to participate in games and events (at least 70%).
  - Team members with <u>any</u> Fs in their courses will <u>not</u> be permitted to participate in any practices, games, or events until grades improve (See handbook for policies related to academic probation)

#### **Tryout Process**

- All athletes tryout every year.
- You will be observed by the WHS coaching staff during clinics and tryouts.
- At the final tryout you will be asked to perform specific skills learned during the tryout process.
- No scores or judging sheets will be distributed after tryouts.
- All decisions are up to the coaching staff and are final.

#### **Tryouts**

- Tuesday, April 23rd, Wednesday, April 24th, and Thursday April 25th
- Completed online registration tryout packet forms, photo and grade report are due **before** participation can begin.
- Please wear athletic shorts, a T-shirt, and cheer or athletic shoes, with hair pulled back in a ponytail.
  - O Hair with hard hair accessories must be pulled up into a bun.
- Please leave all jewelry at home.
- Nails must be trimmed so they are not visible above the tip of the finger. No acrylic nails are allowed.
- Evaluations on attitude, work ethic, learning rate, coachability, flexibility, and tumbling will happen throughout the tryout process, including at open gyms and clinics.
- Deductions may be taken for: jewelry worn at the clinics and tryouts, hair not off the face, painted / fake/ long fingernails.

#### **Performance Material for Tryout**

Arrive on Tryout days prepared to perform the assigned chants. You will also learn material that will help the coaching staff determine your skill and ability level. Evaluations begin immediately upon arrival. Below is a list of the material you will learn and perform at tryouts. You may be asked to execute skills more than once during the tryout process. All cheerleaders will be expected to not only maintain the skills they tried out with, but to improve upon them throughout the season.

- Jumps
- Dance
- Cheer and/or Chant
- Stunting Ability
- Tumbling (Optional Bonus skill)

#### **Formation of Squads**

- Cheerleaders will be placed on squads based on skills demonstrated at tryouts and clinic evaluations.
- Maturity, coachability, and attitude will be observed and taken into account for each candidate.
- The number of athletes on each squad will vary depending on skill level and number of candidates at the tryout.
- We take many factors into account other than your tryout score. Final decisions on team placements are up to
  the coaching staff. Please remember that as coaches, our main goal is to place each individual on a team on
  which they will be the most successful. We are looking not only at skills, but also at growth potential, attitude,
  classroom performance, and willingness to learn. We also take into account the wellbeing of the team as a
  whole.
- Trying out does not guarantee a spot on a squad.

#### Results

- Results will be posted on the website Tryout page.
- The coaches need time to thoughtfully consider each candidate and the needs of the team, but typically the teams will be named within three days of the tryout.
- All decisions are up to the coaching staff and are final.
- There is a no contact rule in place between coaching staff and students/families for 24 hours from roster announcements.

#### **APPROXIMATE Cheer Costs**

Cheerleading is an expensive sport and a large commitment. Each cheerleader is financially responsible for all costs listed, and potentially others that arise throughout the season. Please review the cheerleading financial spreadsheet posted on the website prior to tryouts and make yourself aware of the cost commitment that is required for cheerleading. These are **approximate costs only**. All apparel payments are due at the time of the order. No apparel orders will be placed until paid in full. Other fees will be due throughout the season as indicated on the team Band account. Coaches will need to see and approve all items returning cheerleaders plan to carry over to ensure proper fit and appearance.

# WHS Cheer Code of Conduct 2024-2025

I hereby pledge to be positive about my cheerleading experience at WHS, and accept my responsibility for my participation by abiding to this code of conduct.

- 1. It is my choice to participate in this program. I will inform my coaches of any physical injury or ailment that may harm my safety or the safety of others.
- 2. I will be on time for all practices, activities, events, competitions and other required functions. As a team member, I understand that regular attendance is required and that tardiness and absences can be just cause for action from my coach and may require my removal from the team. I will attend all practices directly prior to games and events, and understand that my failure to do so will result in my suspension from participating in the event and potential further disciplinary action.
- 3. I will demonstrate good sportsmanship by showing respect, courtesy, and positive support for all cheerleaders, players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every practice, game, competition, or event.
- 4. I will strive to do my best to represent my program in a positive way, and set a positive example by following rules (dress code, attendance policy, etc.). I will strive to conduct myself and encourage other students to follow the policies in our handbook. I understand breaching these rules may be just cause for my suspension or removal from the team.
