FAQ: What does my registration fee go to? Tackle Football

- KYFL currently spends more per athlete than we collect in registration fees. The cost for tackle have more than doubled since 2019.
- While the fee for tackle have increased this year, it has not been raised to cover all the costs.
- Registration fees go directly to your athlete.
- Registration fees do <u>NOT</u> pay for:
 - Side By Side/Golf Cart
 - Paint Machine
 - Trailers
 - Cheer Mats
 - Giving Back to the Community (Senior Scholarship, Elburn Food Pantry, Financial Assistance)
- KYFL utilizes fundraising to keep registration fees from increasing at the same rate as our costs and cover additional expenses.
- Special Events, Spirit Wear, and Concessions in addition to fundraising cover our additional expenses and investments.
 - In 2024 additional investments include replacing approximately half of our inventory. See our FAQ on the Helmet Life Cycle for more details on when and why we replace helmets.
