**Sponsorship Coordinator Report**

- Sportsmanship sign placement – fields B/C specifically (walk the park?) - being put up Friday per Greg.
  - Will take a picture prior to permanent fastening
- Peewee/Tball meet the coach event
  - Volunteers needed – see hand out & give feedback.
- 360U discount cards – opinions
- 4 more banner sponsors were secured, which brings total Sponsorship \$\$ incoming this year to \$31,400 for the year thus far. Also, saving ~\$1,500 on free mosquito treatment.
  - \$25,810 from Sponsorship in 2024
  - ~\$12,000 has been or will be used towards Sponsorship costs (banners, wraps, plaques, benches)
    - Next year we will see more keep from banner sponsorships, as we had \$5565 banner spend this year on new banner sponsors!!! (\$265 EACH)
- I need to hang 4 banners, 1 magnet, Plant C bench plaque, & 3 dugout screens yet & then I am ready for opening day!
  - Last dugout screen is being overnigheted at no cost & will be here tomorrow.
  - Volunteers to help? Tonight, or Thursday? I can't be there on Friday.

**Fundraising Report**

- **Apparel Update:** 360 (21 orders), FCE (6 orders), NGE (30 orders), E+A (34 orders)
  - Only fundraiser was E+A (they will be giving us 10% on all order until end of July)
  - Board Member Apparel should be done tomorrow per Nick. I will pick it up and deliver it to you all Saturday
- 2024 Calendar Sales: 777 athletes (not including peewee) = \$23,310 in calendar presale, \$6090 in extra calendars sold 2024 TOTAL calendar fundraising = \$29,400

- 2025 Calendar Sales: 685 athletes (not including peewee) = \$20,550 in calendar presale, \$13,920 in extra calendars (Tuesday night), tonight is still pending
