

Dunlap Recreation Association Basketball Gym Use Policy

Without Court Time, We Have No Basketball Program!

It must be understood that we are an independent youth organization, unaffiliated with the Dunlap Community School District. Even though virtually all of our players attend Dunlap Schools, the schools are under no obligation to provide us with court time. We must all respect the District's facilities in order to continue to be granted use. To that end, the DRA has adopted a "Basketball Gym Use" policy. This policy and its rules will be strictly enforced by all coaches. All parents/guardians are required to review and acknowledge acceptance of this policy during basketball registration.

It is expected that EVERYONE granted use of the gym will take personal ownership for its care and in the enforcement of the rules and regulations. For DRA Basketball this is EVERY COACH, CHILD and PARENT. It is in the best interest for safety, liability, and equipment care that all groups using the gym enforce the rules.

Use of Facility Expectations and Responsibilities

1. **No siblings allowed in the school during practices.**
2. Pets are not allowed in the gym.
3. Stay within the gym. Roaming the halls is not permitted.
4. Restrooms nearest the gym may be used.
5. Do not bounce or pass basketballs outside of the gym.
6. No liquids other than water are allowed in the gym.
7. No eating or gum chewing is allowed in the gym.
8. Clean, appropriate gym shoes should be worn during athletic practices.
9. Do not use any of the school equipment other than the basketball hoops.
10. Arrive only 10 minutes prior to designated start time and leave immediately after.
11. **EVERY CHILD and COACH is responsible for gym cleanup.** Any equipment that has been moved or altered must be returned to its initial state at the conclusion of the event. (I.e. Basketball goals moved back to original position)

Failure to comply with the expectations set forth in this policy shall result in warnings, suspension, probation, and/or removal from the basketball program, as the Board deems appropriate.
