CBA Parents Code of Conduct:

3. Respect officials and coaches: Treat referees and coaches with respect, even if you disagree with their decisions. Understand that they are volunteers or professionals doing their best to create a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

4. Avoid sideline coaching: Allow the coaches to do their job without interference. Refrain from instructing or criticizing players during the game. Instead, cheer them on and offer positive reinforcement.

5. Practice good sportsmanship: Teach your child to respect opponents, shake hands, and congratulate them after the game, regardless of the outcome. Encourage your child to be gracious in victory and defeat.

6. Control emotions: Maintain composure and avoid confrontations or outbursts. Remember that the game is about the kids' development and enjoyment, not about personal agendas or winning at all costs.

7. Keep feedback constructive: If you have concerns or suggestions, address them privately with the appropriate coach or league representative. Avoid confrontations in front of the children or other parents.

8. Follow facility rules: Respect the rules and regulations set by the facility where the games take place. Remember to clean up after practices/games, use equipment appropriately, monitor children at all times, follow parking guidelines, and any other facility-specific policies.

9. Be mindful of language and behavior: Use appropriate language and avoid profanity or offensive gestures. Ensure that your behavior aligns with the values of fair play, inclusivity, and respect.

10. Support a safe and inclusive environment: Promote an atmosphere where all children feel welcome, regardless of their skill level or background. Encourage teamwork, fair competition, and a positive experience for all involved.

Remember, as a parent, your presence and support are essential to your child's enjoyment of the game. By following this code of conduct, you contribute to creating a positive and nurturing environment for all participants.
