## State of New York



Guidelines for the senior season:

- each team will play every team twice.
- I need the games that are going to be counted as league games to me before the season starts. All league games are priority and have to be played.
- you will be seeded for the tournament as of the best record to the worst.
- there are 4 teams, and all will be seeded in the tournament. It is imperative that if you have any knowledge that you can't field a team for the tournament let me know ASAP.

Guidelines for the senior tournament:

- Double game elimination tournament.
- 7 innings
- each coach will pay half the umpires fee, which will be $\$ 90$ per umpire
- 4 teams will split the cost of the tournament, which I will let you know later. This will be paid to me or appointed person before the tournament begins.
- since district tournament is not a national tournament the high seeded team will be the home team until the championship game or games and we will flip for home team.
- each team will supply 6 baseballs ( 12 total) per game to the umpire. Remember diamond baseballs only
- all games will be played the entire 7 innings even if it means you have to finish the next day. There will be a ten (10) run rule after 5 innings.
- all appeals or disputes will be done at the time of the call and before the next pitch.

Guidelines for the junior season:

- each team will play every team four (4) times.
- the top 2 teams will play in a district tournament
- I need the games that are going to be counted as league games to me before the season starts. All league games are priority and have to be played.
- there are 3 teams and the top 2 will go on to a 2 team best 2 out of 3 tournament. It is imperative that if you have any knowledge that you can't field a team for the tournament let me know ASAP.

Guidelines for the junior tournament:

- Best 2 out of 3, 2 team tournament
- 7 innings
- each coach will pay half the umpires fee
- the first 2 games will be played on alternate home fields with the necessary $3^{\text {rd }}$ game being played on a mutual agreed field
- each team will supply 6 baseballs ( 12 total) per game to the umpire. Remember diamond baseballs only
- all games will be played the entire 7 innings even if it means you have to finish the next day. There will be a ten (10) run rule after 5 innings.
- all appeals or disputes will be done at the time of the call and before the next pitch.
