COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Assess the risks

- We have identified areas where people gather
- We have identified situations and processes where people are close to each other and members of the public
- We have identified the equipment that may be shared by individuals
- We have identified the surfaces that people often touch

Implement protocols

- Via sport sector guidelines/sport specific guidelines
- Orders/guidance/notices issued by PHO
- Municipality/facility guidelines
 - Established maximum program numbers
 - Implemented measures to keep participants 2 metres apart whenever possible.
 - We have identified rules/guidelines for how participants/coaches/volunteers/spectators should conduct themselves
 - We have clearly communicated these rules thru training and handbooks

Risk reduction

- We have reviewed the information on selecting and using masks, and instructions how to use masks.
- We understand the limitations on masks, and understand masks should only be considered when other control methods cannot be met.
- We have reviewed the information on cleaning and disinfecting
- Our facilities have enough washrooms and or hand sanitizing stations.
- We have implemented cleaning protocols for all common areas
- We have removed unnecessary equipment to simplify the cleaning process

Develop policies

Our policies ensure that participants and others showing symptoms of COVID-19 are prohibited from playing in sport activities.

- Anyone with symptoms in the last 10 days
- Anyone directed by Public Health to self-isolate
- Anyone who arrived from outside Canada, or come into contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- Our policies address anyone who starts feeling ill during a softball activity

Communication plan and training

- We have a communication plan to make sure everyone is trained in policies and procedures.
- All participants have received policies to stay home when sick.
- We will have posted signage at facilities for occupancy limits/hygiene/physical distancing.
- Coaches and safety officers have been trained on monitoring participants to ensure policies and procedures are being followed.

Monitor and update plans as necessary

- We will make changes to our policies as needed
- Participants know who to go to with health and safety concerns
- When resolving issues, we use health and safety representatives.

Assess and address Risks from resuming activities

- We have training and handbooks in place for all safety officers and coaches
- We have training for volunteers in new roles
- We have clearly stated and have given waivers to all participants
