#### General Overview

- Registration wrapped up

- ~\$35k savings
- ~\$14.5 registration sales
- Candy bars not as popular as last year
  - o Potentially increase the buyout
- Some travel team registrations came in through PO Box
- ~\$7k for raffle prizes (cost)
  - o 30 prizes again
- In general, everything is becoming more expensive so adjustments to fees and review of costs should be done
  end of 2024 Season
- WE Energies does sponsorships of ~70% on lighting projects
  - Quotes will come in to take a look for a potential future project
  - o Prefer updating projects over new construction
  - o Dave Bauer to call Zach Newton to quote upgrade on Field 1 as well
- School has proposed charging using the gyms/facilities as a way to offset debts
  - We will see if this affects anything we do
