#### **Old Business**

- End of the Season Survey
  - No feedback given to coaches and wondering why
    - Clay will compile the comments and put the major points out to the coaches
    - Josh will then use comments for the coaches clinics that are offered as well
- Coach/Player Evaluation
  - 85% returned from at least 1 coach
  - Jason will work on charting it out like the survey results and comprise
  - Will then give them to Scott for use for tryouts and placements
  - 8th Grade was optional so not many results
- Final EAA Approved FY 18-19 Budget
  - Was approved
    - Had to take out late fees as those are not budgeted for
    - Has a net loss of \$2500
      - Will likely raise fees to recoup that amount

### **New Business**

- Open Gym
  - Wednesdays and Sundays starting June 13th
  - Need a board supervisor every night to be there for injuries or any issues that may arise. Nothing has happened but just want to be covered.

- Pat will take care of hiring the refs, Will be high school kids again as it seemed to work well last year.
- Timelines for tryouts
  - Waiting on final dates from high school
  - Pre tryout clinic
    - Sunday afternoons and either Tuesday or Wed night depending on the location
    - Will be using Blackhawk to allow for more kids
    - Instruct kids on what is involved with the tryout process so they are better prepared
    - 5-6 dates
  - With resignation of girls coach will need to make sure nothing gets dropped on the girls side. Clay will take charge.
  - Coach Interviews
    - Will wait on numbers of registered to determine how many coaches needed.

#### Tournament

- With the dates we currently have and the registration numbers from last season we do not have enough gym space for both boys and girls on the same weekend.
- If we split boys and girls we will have more work
  - Eagan High School does not have any other available weekends
  - ECC does not allow for concession revenue so not wanting to rely on them for a site if we don't
    have to.
  - Will check with Inver Grove Heights and gyms available there
  - Eastview does not have any availability and not willing to help out
- Different scenarios brought up
  - Keeping boys the current weekend Nov 4-5
  - Having the girls move weekends but then not able to use St Thomas as a site
  - Have a 1 day girls tournament but also having a smaller boys group to open up space at St.
     Thomas
    - Either a boys B/C tournament
    - Trying a 3rd grade tournament; Supersaver style with 1 day format
- If we split weekends we can use boys to cover for girls for volunteering as well as girls for boys.
- Adding the 3rd grade to the mix adds volunteers
- Assign certain teams to cover blocks of time as long as the team does not have a tournament scheduled that weekend.
- Need a decision in time for brochures to go out may need to bring back to group via email if meeting not early enough.

#### **Other**

- Jackie involved in conversation with Rosemount, Farmington and Eastview about bringing the 4th grade boys and 5-6 grade girls together in a league.
  - o If add Eagan they can add more teams, currently have 13 teams with current participants
  - Game on Saturday mornings two 20 min running time halves
  - Starts Jan 19 and end of season tournament March 9

- o Adult refs paid \$25 per game
- o Records set the tournament seeds
- o Even teams with a draft style to ensure more equal play
- Jason reported that equipment drop went well
  - o Continue with the separate dates as most of the girls uniforms were already returned before boys season even over.
- 10,000 shot club
  - Jack will take charge
  - o Recognize all finishers at halftime of a game.
  - T-shirts for all who complete
  - Drawing for grand prizes
- Board wondering what their involvement can be for hiring of new girls high school coach
  - o Will approach and ask for seat on the interview committee
