"We meet monthly, except in the Summer, and share a simple meal together, while sharing our highs and lows for the past month. At each meeting, we pray together, read scripture, and discuss the monthly topic from our study book. The meetings are hosted at the homes of the TOOL couples, with a spiritual advisor assigned to each team. We pray for each other in our faith journeys. It is so special to spiritually grow together as we gather with other faithful couples. The presence of the Holy Spirit can be felt each time we meet. The power of prayer has brought each of us, as couples closer together.

Being in TOOL has made us more mindful of the sacrament of marriage. It reminds us of the importance of placing God first in our marriage. A cord of three strands is not easily broken."
