





We want the Tigers community to feel safe and know we will be transparent, so parents have the necessary information to make decisions on what is best for their family. Texas Tigers Hockey recognizes future events may prevent any player from participating in leagues or traditional practices due to government/health restrictions, or other events beyond the club's control. If such an event were to occur, triggered by a restriction from a local, state, or national order, or, as a result of the Club exercising its best judgment to protect the participants, I understand that:

- 1. The payment obligation set forth herein shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2. The club will provide services on a "best efforts" basis, determined by the club, given the regulatory and health concerns that may exist.
- 3. In such an event, Texas Tigers Hockey reserves the right to return a pro-rata allocation to the Player, surplus funds if any after the club has fully satisfied its operational commitments including but not limited to Coach/Director Pay, Unreimbursed Ice & Facility Rentals Expense, Unreimbursed League Expenses, and Tournament Fees.
