Dear Baseball Players and Parents:

Hopkins Senior League Baseball is now accepting registrations for summer baseball. Tier I players **must live** within Hopkins School District 270. Tier II players **must live within, or attend school** within the District 270 boundaries. Playing ages are 16-18, with some 19 year olds. This applies to those with birthdays prior to April 30, 2003. Those who are younger but are in at least 10th grade for the 2016 – 2017 school year, may play Tier II.

This league is intended to be a place for players of all skills and abilities. The season will begin around June 1st and end by July 31st.

The fee for summer baseball is \$370. Registrations will be accepted through May 15<sup>th</sup> to allow time for ordering uniforms and determining number of teams. After this date, registrations will be accepted on a space available basis.

Games will be played at Big Willow Park, Hopkins Varsity and Sophomore fields, and nearby metro suburbs.
