Coach Lachowitzer is meeting with the Coaches - they are planning for winter and spring camps and also working on the summer schedule (7 on 7 league, camp..etc.)

Coach mentioned that he would like to add in some joint practices with other schools (we can have up to 11 per year). The plan is to try and get more competition, bring more energy to the field, he is working on dates and times.



- We had a discussion on what more we could do in Buffalo that would be better use of our funds instead of doing a camp like Bemidji. We felt that football camp is a good bonding experience for the kids - the team is together for 3 days with no distractions.
 - We went to Bemidji so we could play against some larger schools larger talent pool.
 - Feedback why did not all kids attend the camp? How do we get more kids to buy into the camps and summer programs?

Communication is great from Coach - having the schedule out to parents early is key.

Middle School Preparations (BCMS and St. Francis) - Talks to the kids about what to expect - maybe bring along current players to help talk to incoming players. Make them feel like they are a part of a family - not intimidating for the kids. Coach will talk about expectations and trying to get the older kids involved with the younger kids - more program cohesion.
