STEVE JACOBS



A native of Hudson, Mass., and 1978 graduate of the University of Massachusetts Amherst, Steve Jacobs brings 40 years of hockey coaching and administrative experience as Varsity Boys' Ice Hockey Head Coach.

In his 32-year-career as a head coach, Coach Jacobs holds an impressive 801-184-39 overall win-loss record. As Head Coach at Cushing, he was instrumental in building the hockey program into one of the top programs in the country, twice winning the Division I title and compiling a 607-117-30 win-loss record. Thirteen of his 22 Cushing teams reached the final four, and six reached the title game. Not a single one endured a losing season.

Coach Jacobs has mentored over 300 players who have gone on to the NCAA ranks, including 159 in Division I; 68 have broken the professional ranks. Some notable former Cushing players include:

TOTAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

Our Total Skills Development program will focus on specific skill development for forwards, defensemen, and goaltenders in a fun and competitive environment. We will teach skating, edge control, stickhandling/puck control, passing, shooting, offensive and defensive play, positional play, and more.

OFF-ICE SESSIONS

Off-ice sessions will include dry land training as well as other hockey-specific training:

- Conditioning/stretching/plyometrics
- Strength training/agility (age appropriate)
- Field sports
- Gymnasium sports
- Shooting station



GOALTENDERS

The camp will limit four goalies to each session, which will allow the goaltenders to be completely immersed in goaltender skills with our dedicated goalie coach. Goaltenders will train separately each day, focusing on skating, puck control, agility, technique, angles, and body positioning. Goaltenders will also participate in full on-ice activities and face various game-like situations with general goaltender instruction.
