2022/2023 Safe Sport Act Compliance Options

- 1. <u>If you completed the ASHA Background Screening and Abuse Prevention Systems Training</u> during the 2021/2022 ASHA Registration Process.
 - a. You are compliant!
 - b. ASHA will verify the completion through our system.
- 2. If you completed the USA Hockey background screening and US Center Safe Sport Core
 Training (including Refresher Courses) through your current season USA Hockey Membership. (This is offered as convenience to help eliminate any duplicating costs for our participants)
 - a. You will be considered compliant upon receipt of your current season USA Hockey Verification Page with approval by your team manager/registrar. Please read instructions carefully to avoid any delays we will only accept this verification page in a specific format.
- 3. Athletes, Volunteers or Coaches: If you <u>need to complete</u> the background screening and abuse prevention training requirements.
 - a. You will indicate this in your season registration. After completing your season registration, a link to complete the background screening & abuse prevention training will be provided through your ASHA Registration. Sports Engine collects a \$30 fee for the NCIS Background Screening & \$5 fee for Abuse Prevention Systems Training
 - b. ASHA will verify the completion through our system.
 - Please note that an Athlete may request a Waiver of Background Screening, only if their member home team does not require the background screening.
- 4. Athletes Only: Athletes may choose to complete the Safe Sport for Youth Athletes Course.
 - a. You will indicate this in your season registration. After completing your season registration, a link to the Safe Sport training course will be provided. This training option is at no cost to the athlete.
 - b. Please note that you will need to set up an account with SafeSportTrained.org to login in to the training.
 - c. ASHA will verify through our partnership with the US Center for Safe Sport completion of this course.
- 5. Athletes Only: A Parent of Guardian may submit a completed "Request For Accommodation"
 - a. This form can be used when a parent/guardian is a registered coach or volunteer who has completed the abuse prevention training and attest to sharing with the athlete.
 - b. This form can be used when the abuse prevention training is not appropriate for the athlete due to cognition or being an abuse survivor.
 - c. This form can be used to request a waiver for the background screening only.
 - d. A parent or guardian should submit a completed Request for Accommodation Form for the athlete to our team manager/registrar. (The form is located on our website under registration and an email with a link to the form will be sent after you have completed your season registration.)
 - e. This form must be printed and signed by hand by a parent or guardian.
 - a. Please note: Your registration will not be approved until a new season Request for Accommodation form is received and approved by your team manager/registrar. Please read instructions very carefully to avoid any delays. The form is available on the website under "Registration"

If required, ALL documentation must be submitted to your team manager/ team registrar for review and submission to ASHA registrars.
