Varsity Overview



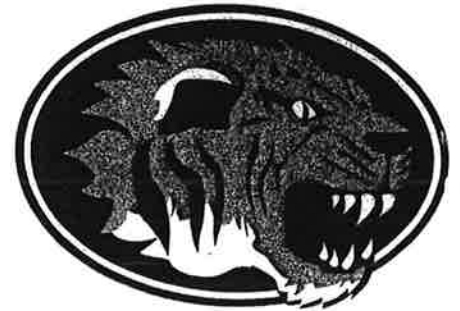

Junior Varsity Overview

The junior varsity team had another outstanding season for the wrestling program. The wrestlers and their parents should be very proud of your accomplishments. Our coaching staff is very excited about the potential of this group and where you're capable of taking the program with continued hard work and dedication. I hope the loss of many starters from this year's team motivates you to have a great off season. Committing to our off season program will allow each of you to take the next step in your *Quest* to become a varsity starter for us next season.

This year's team had a dual meet record of 14-0, another very impressive season for a team that was made up of one freshman, seven sophomores, and six juniors most of the season. The team competed in only two tournaments this season that kept team scores: Chatham Glenwood (3rd Place), and the Southwest Conference (SWC) JV Tournament (1st Place).

At the Chatham Glenwood tournament we were forced to wrestle with only ten of the fourteen weight classes filled due to injuries and mid season growth by many of the wrestlers. The team knew they had their work cut out if they wanted to repeat as team champions. They gave a courageous effort to only miss taking 2nd place by a point and 1st place by twenty-six points.

At the SWC Tournament we beat a very athletic Belleville West team 47-15 in the first round of pool action. We then faced a very inexperienced Collinsville team and showed no mercy by defeating them 75-0. In the championship round we won three of the last four matches to beat a very good O'Fallon team 35-29. As for individual accomplishments the team had six qualify for the finals with two being crowned Conference Champions and three others placing third.

The other two tournaments the junior varsity competed in were the Lafayette and Jackson High School JV Tournaments. Each of these tournaments was run as a round robin which allowed all of our wrestlers to get plenty of mat time. Team points were not kept but the team brought home plenty of individual hardware from each.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting your sons in competing this year in our program. Without your support it would be very difficult to be the team and program we are today. We appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.

I would like to thank the senior wrestlers and managers for your hard work, dedication, and passion for our program the past four years. It really means a lot to me and the rest of the coaches that have had a hand in helping you develop in this great sport over your careers. I would like to thank the parents of the seniors for always being there for your sons/daughters, the coaches, and the Edwardsville Wrestling program. I would also like to thank the rest of the coaching staff from the EWC coaches up to the high school staff for your dedication and hard work in helping continue to make Edwardsville Wrestling one of the top programs in the nation.

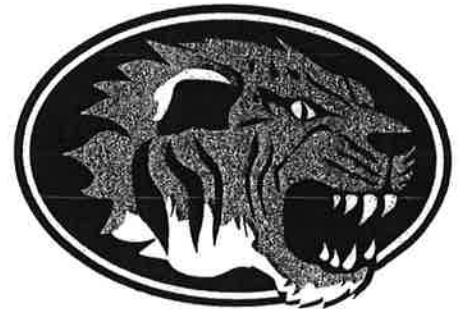
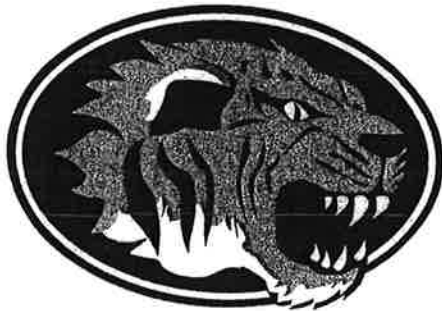
