Initial plan for Quarantine Violation Policy

For those that do not follow the Minnesota Department of Health or their local County Department of Health Quarantine request, the following process will result.

1. Upon a report to either the District 9 Director or the District 9 COVID-19 Coordinator that a Coach, Referee, Player, Spectator or Off-Ice Official has knowingly violated the Quarantine request the following will occur. If player is following parents' direction, no player violation, this becomes a parent violation.
 - a. Investigation by the District 9 COVID-19 Coordinator & Local Association involved will occur.
 - b. A Discipline Hearing with District 9 Hearing Committee will occur within 5 days of initial Association report to review with the party involved. If a minor is involved, the parent or guardian will need to be involved as well.
 - c. 1st offense will be up to an additional 2-week maximum suspension added to the end of the initial quarantine end date. We will distinguish between player and parents.
 - d. 2nd offense will be an additional 30-day suspension added to the end of the initial quarantine end date. We will distinguish between player and parents.
 - e. 3rd time will result in the party not participating in any form for the remainder of the 2020-2021 MN Hockey season.
