My experience running my own modified-RCBA Winterball program in Richmond a few years back is this needs to be booked in schools in the prior year session (January-June) to meet timelines and budgeting usually with the PAC for the upcoming September start of school. I have historical registration increases to prove it works.

I was running upwards of six plus different schools for three consecutive years so there is buy-in on this.

Just think timelines and approaching schools is way off...may also depend on each school district. May be best for Baseball BC to approach a school district PAC president to then hopefully get support to drill down to each individual school. Which I did in Richmond.

• John has volunteered to be on the Baseball BC High-Performance Committee as an observer.

- Baseball BC has undertaken an exhaustive review of their policies and preparation of many more "Safe Sport" policies under direction of Baseball Canada
 - Steve Coleman Lower Mainland, Carmen Martin North Region, Dave Garton -Island Region, to assist in the review.
- Some of these have been adopted, some have been tabled for revisions and some are coming up for review prior to adoption.
- So the question is should we use a top down approach and adopt some or all of these and eliminate duplicate policies within our own rule book or refer to them when our own do not cover everything?

Article V Government

Parts Sec. 1:

The government of the British Columbia Baseball Association shall be vested in a board of 21 directors, of whom:

- a) two (2) will be from Vancouver Island; and
- b) two (2) will be from the Interior of the Province; and
- c) one (1) will be from the Northern region; and
- d) eleven (11) will be from Metro Vancouver the Fraser Valley, or the Sunshine Coast; and e) five (5) will be from any part of the Province of BC who may represent any intended to ensure regional representation for those areas which are unfilled by local regional representatives.

"At each Annual General Meeting, following the election of directors, the Affiliated Associations shall elect from the Board Members the following officers, for a term that expires at the Annual General Meeting: President and Treasurer in ODD numbered years and the 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President and Secretary in EVEN numbered years. The election of Officers shall not exceed the term of their directorship."

 - 22 responses to date with 10 of them in favour of a 13U AAA Single Season (the larger associations seem to be in favour)
 - We would look at tiering AA similar to the Ontario model
 - We would also review registration numbers for declaration
 - Additional survey to go out with a proposed model
 - Tina Baker-Cornett How will that impact the registration numbers rule?
 - John Braaten we will have to review and adjust if needed
 - Grant Butler The Interior/North and Island regions would depend on neighbouring associations to participate.
 - Carmen Martin It will be hard for associations like Prince George due to the lack of neighbouring associations
 - John Braaten Scheduling and Travel will need deep study as the primary concern is travel at this age. More modeling needs to be drafted.
 - Tina Baker-Cornett Mainly concerned that we build a really sound model before we launch to avoid the challenges we have seen prior to COVID in 15U AA.
 - Grant Butler I'd like to see another survey go out with a clearer model of what it will look like and getting feedback on the potential variables. This allows us to have a fruitful discussion at the AGM and hopefully be in a place to implement for 2022 rather than another year go by.
 - John Braaten yes, that is the intention.
