| Coaching Youth is a privilege and one that we take seriously at the MBA. To create a culture of fair play and sportsmanship there must be an understanding of all involved. Our coaches are on the front of this mission, and you set the tone for the responses of the players, families, and officials. These responsibilities mark the importance of your partnership with the MBA. |

| At the beginning of the season, coaches are encouraged to establish and communicate rules of acceptable behavior to players and parents, and the consequences if not followed.   |
| As a coach, you are a mentor and should always be looking for opportunities to praise and encourage the players. At no time is abusive or profane language or actions acceptable.  |
| Coaches are expected to interact with officials and opposing coaches in a professional manner, and to address other coaches with the officials present. Protesting an official's decision during and after a game in an aggressive manner is not acceptable.   |
| Coaches must not use abusive or profane language or gestures, nor induce physical violence towards any official, player, coach, site coordinator, parent, or board members at any time.  |
| Coaches associated with the MBA are expected to promote an environment of fair play and sportsmanship conductive to the youth we serve. A coach in violation of the MBA culture will face termination of coaching privileges.  |
| I have read, I understand, and will abide by the code of conduct for coaches. I also understand that if I break or ignore the rules that are outlined by the above, I may further be subjected to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the MBA. No coach is exempt from these policies set forth by the Board President and Board of Directors of the MBA.           |
