<u>D5 Report:</u> nothing new to report. There was no meeting this month.

Age Level Coordinator Reports: "Start/Stop/Continue" analysis

- o **Jr. Mites/Mites**: Issac Meemken new coordinator to help out.
 - o Goal is to get as much participation on the front end, early with the kids to help increase the number.
 - Held a Mite to Squirt family meeting to review expectations and help answer any questions.
 - o Try Hockey will be in August and early October.

o Squirts:

- 21 kids are moving from squirts to peewees, 28 skaters are staying, 28 are moving from mites to squirts. Numbers include goalies. Looking at a total of 56-58 for sure, there are 7 goalies, which this includes those.
- o Registered for the International tournament in Fargo.

o Peewees:

- o Thinking we will have 41-42 skaters and 5 goalies.
- o Tournaments they have a longer list to review, registered the Peewee AA for the STMA Preview cup and Bemidgi already.

o Bantams:

- Based on last years registration Second yr 20 skaters, 2 goalies, first year, 24 skaters and 1 goalie. 44 skaters, 3 goalies. Thinking there will be 3 skaters that are moving to high school, and they are not accounted for here.
- o 7 of 9 tournaments booked, 2 are picked out, just waiting for the links to open and register.
 - o AA Duluth, STMA and Alexandria
 - B1 Brainard, Duluth, waiting on Rochester
 - o B2 Brainerd, New Ulm, and waiting for Elk River to open

o Girls:

- Working on trying to figure out a U8 program, hoping for a small fee, potentially looking at 44 U8 girls.
- O Doing a 'mixer' for the girls in the summer for them to get to know each other. This would have cross ice games and some open practice.
- o Tryouts they are going to pick one location vs having it at all 3. 9 sessions of dynamics, and a few scrimmages, and a few others with coaches.
- O Looking at these numbers for projections (not set in stone): U8 44 girls, U10 39, U12 42, U15 29 (not sure how many are moving to High School).
- o Looking to join the Sauk Rapids Jamboree for the younger teams.
- The organization is working out some details for the next season on what is needed/asked for from SCYHA.
- o There will be still girls at the Jr Mite/ Mite level at SCYHA, they would do both.

Coach in Charge Report:

No report – nothing new

Goalie Coordinators Report (Jeff/Matt/Tanner):

o 9 goalies at the sessions so far, this last session, they had 10 there. Numbers are great so far. This was opened to the girls too.

Old Business:

- Body contact clinic: Jared is getting more information on Francisco Hockey to present options. Sessions for peewee's and bantams. This will be discussed at a future meeting once the assessment is complete.
- Summer ice times: providing a lot of time for players. Going to test it out with 3-4 sessions. See what the interest is for these sessions. Free. We do need someone there from the association there. Sam Hilde might be able to do this.
- Flat fee dues: not happening due to making this a very tough transition and very complex. Sara is going to provide templates for the teams to help direct them.
- Stronger communication for having goalie coaches at practices throughout the season
- Junior Gold (Kurt): has not been able to connect with the SC AD yet. Cathedral will be making cuts again this year. Kurt is going to continue to try to reach the AD.
- PEP fundraiser camp in Fall: we will be doing this again this year, dates are not set yet. But looking into having this in early September.

New Business:

- Prepare for registration for coaches registration opens up soon, encourage coaches to do their training as soon as possible when it is available. Jenna will send out info as it come out.
- NHC increases getting a new scoreboard and other renovations. Increases to the ice time for Main ice goes from \$190-\$250 and practice rink goes to \$200. September 1st is the effective date of this increase.
- 3 on 3 League Sartell does this, and we would be interested in doing this in St. Cloud skaters. Would run it similar to Sartell. Would start on August 29th through September 24th. Look at scheduling it consistently with the levels and scheduled days of the week.
 - Things to consider/questions/concerns/comments from board:
 - Questioned why we would do this when others are already offering this.
 Keeping it in house for our skaters, it would also align with our dynamic schedules so there would be no overlap. Cost would be low.
 - Might interfere with other sports (football, etc.) due to scheduling. If we could look at a different schedule than other sports so they could do this.
 - Numbers might be an issue, not sure if we would have enough from each level with our own association.
 - Registration opens early and those that want to do it, are already possibly registered. We may be too late, though some may prefer to come here next year if we offered it.
- Logo vote voted for a logo, unanimous vote for the change #3 selection
- Declarations
 - Squirts 49-51 skaters squirts, 7 goalies 4 teams, A, B1, B2, C
 - Motion to approve: 1st Lacy 2nd Matt
 - PeeWee 42 skaters, 3 teams. Potentially 5 goalies. AA, B1, B2
 - Motion to approve: 1^{st} Sam 2^{nd} Matt
 - Bantams 44 skaters and 3 goalies. 3 teams. AA, B1, B2
 - Motion to approve: 1st Maria 2nd Troy
- HP 15 volunteers: Hockey center doesn't have enough volunteers for this program, and asked for SCYHA for volunteers to staff their program. Jared is going to send out an email to see if there is interest.

Open Forum:

- 2 week camp that SCYHA is going to take (previously was a Diana Klatt camp). We would offer this for Mite, Squirt, Peewee, Bantam. 10 sessions of ice time. First few weeks in August. More details to come.
- o Looking at hiring another coach for Learn to Skate since Diana has now departed.
- o Would like to bring back micro-mites if we have the numbers.
- We are going to be in the St. Joe parade, Allyson S. is running this and has enough volunteers.
