# 2024 Important Dates

## **Registration**

2024 Hibbing Youth Baseball registration will be held from 5 to 8 p.m. Monday, Feb. 12, and Tuesday, Feb. 13, in the Hibbing Early Learning Center cafeteria.

A signed medical release form must be turned in at registration as well as a Parent Code of Conduct form. These are available at: [www.hibbinglittleleague.org](http://www.hibbinglittleleague.org).

Any parent wishing to be a coach, assistant coach or a league volunteer must be board approved. If interested, please complete the background check document and provide their social security number prior to commencing any activity with players. ## **Player Evaluations**

Player Evaluations are for Minor League, Little League and Iron Range Baseball. All teams at those levels will be reformed this year using a new method in an attempt to create the most even teams possible. Player Evaluations dates are TBD, but are expected to be held in early May. Please check our website or Facebook page for updates. Please bring a glove, bat and batting helmet to tryouts if you have them.

## Fees Breakdown

There's a base fee for all levels of play. In addition, each player is required to sell raffle tickets. Parents are required to prepay for the raffle tickets. Families of more than two kids must only purchase raffle tickets for the two oldest children. The quantity of raffle tickets varies by level of play.

NEW: Parents of Minor League and Little League players must volunteer for two hours per kid in the two combined levels. A refundable \$50 fee per kid in Minor League and Little League will be charged at time of registration. This fee will be refunded at the end of the season contingent on the required volunteer hours being completed.

The fees are:

- Transition (6-7) = \$110
  - \$60 registration fee
  - \$50 raffle tickets
- Minor League (8-10) = \$245
  - \$120 registration fee
  - \$75 raffle tickets
  - \$50 refundable volunteer deposit
- Little League (10-12) = \$260
  - \$135 registration fee
  - \$75 raffle tickets
  - \$50 refundable volunteer deposit
- IRB (13-14) = \$260
  - \$160 registration fee
  - \$100 in raffle tickets

## Refund Policy

Refunds (less a \$25 administration fee) are available, upon written request prior to April 30. After April 30, a refund request may be submitted in writing to the league president and is subject to board approval for exceptional cases ONLY, such as moving out of town, major injury, etc. These refunds, if board approved, will also be less a \$25 administration fee.
