Approval of Minutes

The October Meeting Minutes were presented and approved without corrections.

General Update – Chris Johnson

- Introduction of any guests
 - o There were no guests at this meeting.
- The following new board members were approved.
 - o Stephanie Shatirishvili voted and approved as the Secretary
 - Chad Shaw voted and approved as the Co-Equipment Manager
 - Tony Tomanek voted and approved as the Co-Equipment Manager
 - o Tim Wilcox voted and approved as the Field Coordinator position
- Meetings will continue at the Fire Station next month, Chris will speak to coordinator regarding this week's room reservation issue

Financial Reporting - Diane Relan

- Monthly financials
 - October 31ST was year end
 - Net loss of about \$11k
 - Revenue was down \$15k from 2018.
 - Currently there are two bank accounts for HBA, Americana in Chanhassen and First Community.
 Discussion regarding accounts. Motion to close the Americana account and transfer all funds and banking to First Community; 2nd and carries.
 - Discussion regarding second signer held, Brenda to be removed from as the second signer and Sam to be added. Motion, 2nd and carries.
 - General discussion regarding financials. There are fewer players coming into the program, expectation of 35-40 new players. 12-year old is larger, 13 is smaller. Equipment purchases and uniforms were discussed. Uniforms were included in the registration fees, no new uniforms were/needed.
 - o Grant: Grant for tractor, turf and nets, \$2000 HBA obligation, grant approval for \$9,866.

Travel Team Items - Tyler Brodersen

- Tournaments are posting. There will be 4 tournaments for each team.
- Discussion regarding number of players (9), batting status quo, 9 batter lines-ups.
- Coaches will have input on tournament selection.
- Travel Coaches needed: 1 13's coach; 3, 14's coaches; 1 15's coach.
- Coach selection process managed by the Player Development Coordinator, Travel Coordinator, VP and President. Presentation of the coaches selected will be made to the board.
- Discussion regarding Dome and gym opportunities. \$20/session or \$150 for all.
- \$590 was the fee for the season, all levels. Regular season installments offered resulting in more fees being collected. Net Loss of \$11,000. Discussion regarding fundraising, increasing fees, reducing the number of tournaments. Suggestion made for a reduction to 1 State tournament and families of that team could fund a 2nd tournament. The Coach would need to agree.
- Plans to pay for 3 tournaments discussion, Gopher State opening Jan 10th.
