- Josh Curry seconded the motion.
- Motion carried unanimously

- Budget meeting was held prior to this meeting today
- Jean Whetstone presented a motion to accept the proposed budget to present at the annual meeting for approval.
- Ben Nicely seconded the motion.
- Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business

14U Duals

- Pat Culp reported that this was our last year for 14U Duals.
- There were 4 teams that went into true seconds.
- Other teams had to wait, some teams said they were done and other teams were upset because they had waited and then weren't getting to wrestle.
- This tournament is going to Pennsylvania for 2 years.
- Asked the board if we want to bid again for 14U?
- Discussion of cost of trip and loss/earnings of hosting.
- Ben Nicely made a motion that we should not bid for 14U.
- Lauren Rioux seconded the motion.
- Discussions around the fact that Indiana started tournament.
- Ben Nicely amended his motion, asking that ISWA table the motion until the next budget meeting.
- Jean Whetstone seconded the amendment to his motion.

Motion to table carried.

Freestyle Qualifiers

- Pat Culp reported that we are still having them these helped the clubs.
- Currently Junior Nationals UWW, Flo Nationals, NHSCA high school nationals, 15U world team qualifiers (Vegas), Western Regional (any USA Regional) counts toward the qualifier requirements.

Fargo Professional Photographer

- Pat Culp stated that this is in the budget. Discussions about photographing athletes in Fargo
- She asked to make sure action shots are taken for both boys and girls.

Waivers for trips

- Code of Conduct for wrestlers (listing all violations) states if you violate certain items, you are going home on your parents' dime. We will no longer tolerate these types of situations.
- There are lesser violations that will not end up in athlete being sent home.

Computer Status

- Jennifer Ratliff is hoping to get 12 new computers and 12 new cameras.
- Will be looking at status of those that we have. Will have at least 10. Have to purchase by 8/31 for this year's budget.
- Mark Mundy mad a motion that we wipe all of the wrestling stuff off of the computers that we will no longer use and donate to boys' club or a like thing.
- Ben Nicely seconded the motion.
- Motion carried unanimously.

Tournament Crew

- J.D. Minch presented an idea that he would like to hire a crew to load and unload the truck for our state/national tournaments due to not always getting much help at these tasks.
- Ryan Parrish made a motion to let J.D. Minch hire a crew
- Josh Curry seconded the motion.
- Motion caried unanimously.

Bylaws

- Pat Culp asked if anything needs to be changed in the bylaws because we review every 2 years.
- Discussions around when the annual meeting occurs.
- Josh Curry made a motion to have the annual meeting on a different weekend in September instead of the 2nd Sunday in September.

Vice Chair- Administration - Ben Nicely

- Following up with officials/pairers from Fargo.
- No report from Disciplinary Committee.

• Tournament Director – Roby Webster

- Not much to report.
- Bids went out to clubs wanting to host tournaments.
- Need to get bids in.
- Sanction forms should be out for clubs hosting local tournaments.
- If you sanction and are not at the bid meeting, it will not count as correctly bid.
- Someone from the club has to be at the annual meeting to bid a tournament.
- Local sanctions have to be in by the Thursday before the annual meeting.
- If adding the day of the annual meeting it has to be in by 9am day of annual meeting.
- Bids for state tournaments have to be in by October 1.
- Different deadline for 2 years out.

Hospitality Director – Linda Robinson

- Report is in.
- Scholarships will be adding a step this year. When applicants put in their application, will check to see if they are an active member this year. Will be a manual process. JD can check applicants as he volunteered to do so.
- Mark Galka (per Tina Tonte) felt there were not schools in his area putting in applications.
- Linda said in the past we sent letters to the schools to let them know of the program. Linda thinks we need to get back to sending letters.
- Jennifer Pierson asked her to remind the social media group to post things when the process begins.

Pairing Officials Developmental Director – Jennifer Ratliff

- Several pairers participated at national events.
- Divisions USA has moved to Masters division instead of University, Senior, etc., thinks we should line up with USA Wrestling.
- Ben Nicely made a motion that we align with USA Wrestling for the division change.
- Jake O'Neill seconded the motion, adding Peewee.
- Motion carried, unanimously.
- Tournament bidding: asked them to have head official, head pairer and trainer. Needs to be listed on sanctions.
- Beth Lybarger has volunteered to work on a database to aid local tournaments in identifying/assigning to their tournaments.

Indiana Representative to National Pairings – Jean Whetstone

- Annual report is in
- We had pairer that went to Fargo and passed her P1. She is now a P1C.
- Made a suggestion for Folkstyle state and Freestyle/Greco state, girls should have a different color championship shirt.
- We need shirt for master level state champs as well.

Equipment Director – Jonah Odum

Annual Report is in.

- Has had lots of challenges with Rudis. Timing was a big issue, mixing of teams.
 Trouble with getting right gear.
- Looking to make improvements for next year.
- Will have specific requirements for vendors for the future.
- Would like to have orders go directly to the athlete's homes.
- Would like to be able to whittle down the cost.
- Jason Miller asked if it worked to use the same gear from trip to trip.
- Jonah said that didn't happen.
- Tina Tonte had a suggestion. One is instead of ordering gifts for the annual meeting, we have 134 bags in garage. Instead of making a purchase for those who attend, we could give a bag to the clubs that are in attendance
- Roby Webster made a motion to use product left over to give to clubs in attendance at the annual meeting
- Linda Robinson seconded the motion.
- Motion carried, unanimously.
- Provided names of athletes that placed.
- Nathan Thomasello came in for a camp at St. Jude catholic school. Excellent camp.
- Jimmy Tonte stated that Steve Livingston brought up treating the Schoolboy Duals (14U) as we treat Heartland Duals and Kids' Nationals in Utah (for travel purposes).
- Discussions regarding travel and comparison to our experience with girls' 14U duals. A
 lot of parents are not comfortable with children of that age traveling with the group and
 prefer to travel with their athlete.

Olympic Styles Mat Officials Director – Mark Mundy

- Would like to change name of his title. Would like to see it changed to Olympic styles Officials director.
- Had 9 referees in Fargo. 4 sent home with covid and direct contact.
- A lot travel to nationals and international tournaments.
- Morgana Landrum is on steering committee for alternate styles of wrestling.
- Received award in Fargo award. Lifetime achievement award.
- Always recruiting. Need more officials. Will continue to recruit and train officials.

Folkstyle Referees Developmental Director – Jim Littlejohn

- Annual report submitted.
- We have Section officials for each section.
- Section 3 Jared Curcio took over for Dan Feser as he moved out of state. Should be state eligible this year.
- Has been in contact with Pete Isais: 10/28-10/30 for pre-season nationals.
- Next year 10/27–10/29 for pre-season nationals.
- Heartland Duals 3/24-3/26 for 2023 and 3/28-3/30 for 2024 (Easter weekend).
- Jason DeLois mentioned girls don't typically wrestle Greco.
- Someone is looking at setting up a girls' Greco nationals in the next year or so.
- Folkstyle Nationals: 3/31–4/2 2023 and then 4/5–4/7 2024.
- Will be head official again for Pre-season Nationals and assistant head official for Heartland Duals.

- Everything went off pretty well.
- Was able to condense junior duals down to one bus.
- She came in a little late last year. Pat Culp said she did a great job.

- Will provide a schedule once completed.
- Will send email blast to all membership for information.
- Nominating committee emailed ballots on 7/1 closed on 8/4 at 11pm.
- had 20% response. 47 responses.
- Need to get clubs to keep their information up to date so that appropriate individuals are receiving the ballots and emails for clubs.

Women's Director – Jason DeLois

- Had 30 girls participate at Fargo.
- Up 11 from last year for about 50% growth.

- Looking at changing Fargo camp for the girls. Greco was gone over in the camp and girls don't wrestle Greco. If it was separate, the girls have different needs and would help to have it separated.

- Mark Mundy wanted to discuss coaches' conduct. He has heard a lot of comments about Indiana coaches conduct mat side. These things come back to referees, and it reflects on the state.
 - Danny asked how we go about installing a rule that a coach gets a yellow card on Saturday and it feeds over to Sunday – some people push the envelope
 - Would like to see a reporting system that if a coach gets a yellow card at Folkstyle state it would be carried over to Freestyle state or Greco state.
 - o Discussions around how to handle these types of situations.
 - o Roby Webster made a motion that if a coach gets a yellow card on Saturday, then it will carry over to Sunday (a weekend yellow card).
 - Will work on this for policies and procedures.
 - o Ben Nicely said this doesn't need to be voted on. Policies and procedures will be updated for a weekend yellow card.
