



FC 1974 Phase 4 Tournament Guidelines

LTSC Venue Guidelines

- Playing field access will be restricted to staff and players participating in games - parents should remain in cars or practice social distancing on sidelines.
- All bleachers will be roped off and not used. Spectators are expected to bring their own chairs.
- Cars should be staggered upon arrival with a minimum of 1 parking space between vehicles.
- Player use of personal protective equipment (mask) from parking lot to field and field to parking lot.
- It is recommended that masks are worn when social distancing is not possible.
- Porto potties positioned around the facility and restrooms on field 1 will be open and sanitized regularly.
- Pop up Tents will be allowed as long as they are in low traffic areas, social distanced from one another and include same household or family members.
- Concession stand will be open and follow Illinois Restaurant and Bar Guidelines. Masks will be required to purchase items from concession stand and concession carts.
- LTSC Staff and GLSA Officers will monitor capacity limits and social distancing.

Game Play Guidelines

- Players should remain in the cars until 30 minutes prior to the game, then begin team warm up.
- Social distancing should be maintained before and after games.
- On-site benches will be removed and players will need to bring their own chairs and spaced 6 feet apart.
- No pre-game walkouts.
- No pre or post game handshakes, instead for sportsmanship teams should engage in a round of applause following the conclusion of the match.
- Maintain an attendance log for every match. Club should keep the attendance log on file for duration of each season for tracing purposes. This includes coaches, players and spectators.
- All teams are expected to provide appropriate infection prevention on their bench.
- Coaches must maintain social distancing from all participants.
- It is recommended that coaches wear masks when instructing during games.
- Players and spectators should leave the field following the conclusion of the match and proper cool down.
- No post game coach talks.

- Game times should be spread out with a recommended 60 minutes between matches at a field to allow teams to properly clear before players arrive for next match.
- Fields will be staggered to minimize traffic areas and maintain 50% venue capacity.
- Water breaks will be enacted at natural stoppages midway through each half. Players should have their own water available and not share water.

Spectator Guidelines

- Spectators will sit behind spectator lines along sideline. These will be dashed lines. In order to maintain proper social distancing, individuals will sit in spaces between the dashes.
- Family Areas for spectators from the same residence will be allowed at corners of the field, and behind the goals at least 6 feet apart from one another and 6 feet off the sideline.
- Fans in attendance must remain in their designated area and attendance of families attending must be kept by respective club.
- Spectators should leave field immediately after coach has dismissed the players.
- Spectators should wear masks when moving around the complex.
- It is recommended that families bring as few spectators as possible.
- It is recommended that people with pre-existing conditions and those with high risk do not attend.

Insurance

To be covered by Illinois Youth Soccer (IYSA) insurance Illinois Restore Phase 4, the IYSA Member club/league must abide by the following requirements:

1. The practice/training/game must be a formal organized activity by an IYSA Member club/league for IYSA Member League players only.
2. The participants including players and coaches must be registered with and have a current, valid pass from the IYSA Member League and must be on file with the IYSA.
3. The Member club/league must have a signed "IYSA Communicable Disease Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement" on file for each participant including but not limited to the players, coaches, staff, volunteers prior to the start of the first practice/training/game.
4. The IYSA does not provide any insurance coverage for Covid-19 related claims.
5. The practice/training/game must abide by all the requirements listed in the IYSA Return to Activity Protocol.
6. The IYSA Member club/league must complete and submit to the IYSA prior to its first practice/training/game the "IYSA Organization Communicable Disease Agreement".
7. Failure to follow the state and local government public health orders, Centers for Disease Control guidelines and IYSA protocol involving COVID-19 or any other communicable disease may void medical and liability coverage for your organization under the IYSA insurance placements.
