Board Member Updates

Barb Metcalf/Parent Liaison:

- **Evaluation Warm-up Night:** Hoping to have six high school players help out on the evaluation warm-up nights.
- The shooting machine has arrived. Over half is paid for and players are loving it.
- **Account balance** is \$2,971.07. They will use \$2,000 to pay towards the machine. Kids are really excited about it and have plans to get kids to use it.
- **3v3:** Begins September 11th. Starting with skills drills, get kids on the ball machine, etc.
- **Freedom Tournament:** November 1oth and 11th: Stacy and Janice have a one pager to help advertise. Coaches are excited about it. \$100 includes a guaranteed three games and t-shirt.
- AAU reached out to Barb to get kids involved. She will share those opportunities.

- **Funding:** Wondering what the board will be funding this season. She has given a google doc with program needs for the board to consider funding. Board will discuss the next meeting.
- **Player Help:** Chris is asking that we could have players available to help with our tournament. Players have a scrimmage in Wayzata that day.
- Janice will email coaches about participating in 3vs3.
- Teams: Right now there are plans for a sophomore, JV, and Varsity team.
- **Special Nights:** Schedule of special nights has been run by Barb. First event is Parents Night. Michelle Guida will work to put together an order and give to Andrew/JJ Athletics. Should have supplies and shirts by the time the special event nights begin.

President updates:

- MYAS Tournament: contacted Chris about holding a tournament in the winter. Chris is hesitant, due to all we have going on with our own tournament and would be concerned about doing it well enough. Ryan will apply for the MYAS tournament, which will be held on the same weekend as the Buffalo Plaid. It would be a boys and girls tournament. If approved, we would use this tournament in place of the Plaid, then register all of our teams for this one.
- Wednesdays Nights: About 20 kids attended every week, saw lots of improvement. Looking ahead to next year, we should consider making the night three hours and split the session into two - first for the younger kids, second for the older. Focus on shooting.
