- Teams will play at least 12 scheduled games with weekday playoffs included for the top four teams of each division.
- Games will be played on Monday through Thursdays. Starting in mid-May through July (Some exceptions may apply)
- Games must be completed by July 15th or they will not count towards the regular season.
- Each team will have the opportunity to nominate player(s) for the All Star games in July! (If teams would like to do one).
