



## **Ontario Soccer Coach Development Video Evaluation Appeal Process**

Coaches may appeal an unsuccessful evaluation and/or the evaluation process or procedure. Appeals of an unsuccessful evaluation, excluding those related to the evaluation process or procedure, must be made as follows:

Appeal must be made, in writing, to Ontario Soccer Manager of Coach Development within 14 days of the receipt of the evaluation report / observation of competency form and include the following:

- · A formal letter, which must include clearly stated rationale for the appeal;
- Session Plan,
- EAP
- Video Information Form
- Consent forms (signed by parents of all players, videographer and Technical Director)
- Coach evaluation form or Observation of coaching competency form
- All documentation related to the pre-brief, formal evaluation(s), debrief, and action plan;
- Payment of the Appeal Fee of \$250.

## **Appeals Process**

On receiving the complete appeal documentation, the following process will take place within the next 30 working days;

- 1. Video recording of candidate's evaluation will be re-evaluated by an alternate Ontario Soccer Coach Evaluator.
- 2. The secondary evaluation will be provided to candidate with result being final and binding.
- 3. If the appeal is successful the appeal fee will be refunded; however, if the appeal is unsuccessful, the appeal fee will be forfeited.

If an appeal is unsuccessful, the coach may need to re-engage in the evaluation process or complete specific areas for improvement. If another formal observation is required, it must will be completed with a different Coach Evaluator.
