The Lee Community Center is facing a large number of improvements to continue to provide our community with great memories for years to come.

We are asking hockey association members to support the Lee Community Center so it can continue to provide opportunities to the surrounding area.

Many families in counties surrounding the Lee Community Center gather here for many activities year-round:

- Morris Hockey Association offers varying levels of hockey comprised of 10 teams and nearly 150 players.
- Walking Track: open year-round to the community
- Community sponsored events:
 - Free Skating Events: Spook-n-Skate, Skate with Santa, Open Skate and Open Hockey
 - Community Expo's: Spring Expo and Stevens County Fair
 - Community Events: Post Prom, 4-H events, Safety Day Camp, Relay for Life, Easter Egg Hunt, Baseball Practices, School PE Classes, Circus and Community Meals
 - Individuals and groups may also rent the rink for celebrations, parties and wedding receptions.

The Lee Community Center is currently facing the following major improvements **estimating nearly \$250,000:**

• **Purchasing and Installing a Dehumidification System:** This is needed to reduce the humidity in the air which will improve air quality and minimize structural decay. *Stevens County has approved roof repair/door replacement contingent on this system being installed.*

Estimated Cost: \$95,000

• **Replacement/Reskinning of the Boards:** The current boards were installed in 1994 and were from Mariucci Area. They have seen years of use which has caused significant wear on the boards.

Estimated Cost: \$50,000

• **Government Mandated Replacement of the Cooling System:**

Environmental laws are now requiring a more environmentally friendly refrigerant system to be in place.

Estimated Cost: \$100,000

We would like to thank you for your efforts in raising \$36,000 so far. We need your help to complete these projects and your support is crucial to our efforts. It is estimated this will be a three-phase project that will be completed by 2021.
