HEADS UP, DON'T DUCK!

Concussion Signs Observed by Coaching Staff

- Appears dazed or stunned
- Confused on assignment or position
- Forgets sports plays
- Is unsure of game, score, or opponent
- Moves clumsily
- Answers questions slowly
- Loses consciousness (even briefly)
- Behavior or personality changes
- Can't recall events prior to hit or fall
- Can't recall events after hit or fall

Symptoms Reported by Athlete

- Headache or "pressure" in head
- Nausea or vomiting
- Balance problems or dizziness
- Double or blurry vision
- Sensitivity to light
- Sensitivity to noise
- Feeling sluggish, hazy, foggy, or groggy
- Concentration or memory problems
- Confusion
- Does not "feel right"

Action Plan

- 1. Remove athlete from play
- 2. Ensure athlete is evaluated by health care professional
 - Do not try to judge the seriousness of the injury yourself
- 1. Inform athlete's parents about the possible concussion
- 2. Allow athlete to return to play **only** with permission from health care professional
