PARENT / LEGAL GUARDIAN - CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a parent/legal guardian of a child involved in a program of WWFHA, I agree to abide by and follow the rules and guidelines below:

- I will remember that my child participates in hockey for their enjoyment, not mine.
- I will abide by the 24 hour "cooling off" period before approaching a coach, manager or board member with a grievance.
- I will promote the physical and emotional health of the athletes ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship through my actions by demonstrating positive support for all players.
- I will require my athlete to treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sexual orientation, gender or ability.
- I will treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity in language, behavior and attitude.
- I will recognize that the coach has the final say regarding the allocation of ice time among players in certain game situations including, but not limited to penalty kills, and the last few minutes of a close game.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my athlete or others.
- I will respect the property and equipment used at any sports facility.
- I will comply with a zero tolerance policy for misbehavior related to drugs and alcohol at any event and for threatening behavior to players, parents, volunteers and administrators.
- By agreeing to part of a WWFHA program, I agree to making required payments in a timely manner either in person, by mail, or online.
