Awards for 1st, 2nd & Consolation Champs

- All Games will be played at Kaukauna High School Gymnasiums
- 28.5 inch balls will be used. Home team will furnish game ball and each team must furnish their own practice balls
- WIAA Rules Apply
- All Games will be 18 minute halves with a running clock. Clock will stop the last 2 minutes of each half for dead balls.
- No All-Star Teams Allowed. School District teams only.
- Players can play up, but not down. Team will be placed in the grade of the oldest player.
- No Maximum Roster, but only 15 awards will be given.
- Concessions will be sold on site, No Carry-Ins please & tobacco free environment
- Admission will be charged. Two coaches per team admitted free.
- Rules will be sent at a later date

Teams for Tournament registration and payment is completed online. The first 8 registered teams for each grade will be accepted. When the online registration reaches 8 teams for any grade the link to register for that grade will automatically display “Out of Stock”. The **Kaukauna Youth Girls Basketball Tournament** is an official Qualifier for the 2024 Wisconsin State Middle School Basketball Championship to be held in Madison, WI in March of 2024. All teams finishing 1st or 2nd in each division will qualify for the State Championship to battle top teams from towns throughout Wisconsin.

*If less than an 8-team bracket in a grade level, team awards may be different than stated

Rules for KGBA Tournaments

W.I.A.A. referees will officiate each game. Coaches, players and fans are asked to show courtesy and demonstrate good sportsmanship throughout the tournament. Anyone unable to follow guidelines and display good sportsmanship will be asked to leave for the remainder of the tournament.

1. All decisions and results of the referee or the tournament director(s), is final and without appeal in case of a dispute.
2. KGBA shall not be responsible for personal injury or loss of team or individual property.
3. All team jerseys must be numbered, with a reversible jersey recommended.
4. Each team will provide either a score clock operator or score book official for each game.
5. Games will start early if possible. Forfeits will be enforced if late for the start of a game. Game times may change if running ahead or behind schedule.
6. Intentional and technical fouls will result in an automatic two points, and possession of the ball. a. Any player or coach accumulating two technical or intentional fouls during the duration of the tournament will be ejected from the tournament.
7. Games will consist of two 18 minute halves. The game clock will run continuously, except for injuries and timeouts, until the last two minutes of each half when the clock will also stop for all dead ball situations.
 - a. The desired pregame warmup is 4 minutes, unless the courts are behind schedule, then the warmup can be reduced to 3 minutes.
 - b. Halftime is 3 minutes.
8. Each team will be allowed 3 time outs per game. No timeouts are allowed to be carried over to overtime.
9. Bonus Free throws will be awarded on the 7th team foul and the double bonus on the 10th team foul.
10. Overtime Rules:
 - a. 1 timeout per team per overtime period. No carry over of any unused timeouts.
 - b. 1st overtime will be 2 minutes, with the clock stopping on all dead ball situations
 - c. 2nd overtime will consist of the 5 players on the court at the end of the 1st overtime shooting 1 free throw each. The team that makes the most out of 5 wins the game. If tied after 5, sudden death free throws will ensue, still rotating the 5 players on the floor.

7th and 8th grade rules:

1. Any defense allowed anytime.
2. Full court press allowed anytime, or until a team is ahead by 15 or more points.
