Squirt Commitment

- Players turning 9 prior to June 1, 2023, must play Squirts
- Players turning 9 on or after June 1, 2023, that are going into 4th grade have the option to move up to Squirts
- Players turning 9 on or after June 1, 2023, but in a grade lower than 4th grade may attend evaluations for Squirts, but must be placed on a B-1 or A team in order to stay in Squirts
- Time Commitment: 4-6 ice times/team activities each week
- 3 tournaments per team (Sqt A team has a 4th this year due to abridged District 3 schedule)
 - Thanksgiving weekend (Mpls Cup for B1, B2 and C teams, Hopkins Tourney for A team)
 - Local (drive time within 45 mins)
 - Out of town (drive time greater than 90 minutes)
 - Tournaments can (and often do) have morning or mid-day Friday games even on non-holidays

Expectations from Parents

- SportsEngine (RSVP attendance for each event)
- Sportsmanship
 - Positive Coaching Alliance class required if this is your first time in Squirts Oct
- Home Game Duties
 - Running score board, working penalty box, and keeping stats
- Dibs hours
 - 12 hours of volunteering hours posted on the MHA website
 - Don't wait until the end of the season to sort this out
 - Teams with several coaches helping be aware that not all coaches may get Dibs

Preseason Squirt Clinics

- Schedule
 - mplshockey.com> program info> clinics & evaluation> Squirts
- Three skating groups for preseason clinics starting with last name (A-H, I-O, P-Z)
 - Starts on Sept 9th and ends on October 2nd
 - Each player following their alpha designations will have 12 sessions available to skate
 - Please try to attend your assigned sessions
 - Exceptions for players who have a parent on the ice for that clinic and goalies playing goalie at that clinic
- Coaches
 - All coaches have to be registered with all certifications complete and verified by ACE coordinator, except for CEP class, in order to be on the ice for clinics no exceptions
 - Coaches meeting in September

Evaluations – Dates and Pools

- All evaluation information will be posted on the Squirt clinic & evaluation page
 - mplshockey.com> program info> clinics & evaluation> squirts
- Evals start on Oct 5th and will be completed by Oct 15th
 - Goalies will have goalie-specific evaluations September 23rd and September 24th
 - Goalies will also attend player evaluations as goalies for further evaluations
- After registration closes, you will be contacted and asked to select an evaluation pool
- New this year, we will start with a A-only pool on October 5.
 - There will be a \$50 entry fee for A pool tryouts
- The B1/B2/C Pool will start on October 10th
- All A/B1/B2/C Pool ice times will be posted on the Squirt clinic and evaluation page

Evaluations – A Pool

- Signing up for the A Pool evaluations does not guarantee placement on the A or B1 team
- Players are not guaranteed to stay in the A Pool evaluations for more than one session
- Participating the A Pool evaluations does not provide preferential scoring or ranking for the B1/B2/C Pool evaluations that follow
- Players not selected to participate in the final day of A Pool evaluations will continue to be evaluated in the B1/B2/C Pool evaluations that will begin after the A Pool evaluations are complete
- There will be 3 session days for A Pool evaluations with a 4th day involving an officiated scrimmage with an outside association
- Non-goaltender players selected to return for the scrimmage will either be placed on the A team or auto-placed on the B1 team

Evaluations – B1/B2/C Pool

- All Players in B1/B2/C Pool start with a clean slate
- No scores are carried over from A Pool
- Evaluations will take place over 5 session days
- No player will skate in more than 3 session days once B1/B2/C Pool begins
- Skating pools are reconstituted after every session for the following session
- Goal is to give players opportunity to go against different players during their sessions

Evaluations – Process and Evaluators

- Players should arrive 1 hour prior to first evaluation and 30 minutes prior for the rest
 - Suggest player having ½ equipment already on
- Must remove or cover player's name from jersey and all outward showing gear
- Skater will be assigned a pinnie at first evaluation check in for entire evaluation
 - Return pinnie after last evaluation (\$15 fee if unreturned)
- Parents allowed to come into locker room to tie skates, but can't watch evaluations
- Should have between 4 8 evaluators per session
 - Typically, at the level of an ex-college hockey players or a person with extensive coaching experience
 - No parents of squirt players can be evaluators

Evaluations – Team Selections

- After each evaluation day players will be identified by their pinnie number
 - Storm Squirt website will be source of notification for player outcomes
- Important take aways
 - Player-first hockey evaluation
 - We will not take coach/manager team needs into account when leveling a player
 - Ultimate goal is to place each player at a level where they will be challenged to improve and still have the opportunity for individual growth and success
 - First year C player can turn into second year A player

Team Levels/Numbers

- Team numbers based off of squirt survey and last year's numbers
- 9th team possible
 - Number of kids registered
 - District 3 approval
 - Tournaments
- We will seek to build balanced rosters at levels where we have multiple teams.
- The jump from Mites to Squirts is substantial
- This is the start of the journey
