

Proof of Grade: Any team participating in the 2022 KOG must have proof of each player's grade

available at the KOG playing site. This information does $\underline{\textit{NOT}}$ need to be submitted

to the MYAS prior to the tournament.

Listed below are a few examples of documentation that will prove an athlete's grade eligibility.

- Signed letter, on school letterhead, from school official verifying player's name and grade level
- <u>Copy</u> of current student I.D. with player's name, school year and grade level clearly indicated
- <u>Copy</u> of current report card with player's name, school year and grade level clearly indicated

It is strongly recommended that teams request a letter from the players' school(s) that identifies them by name and grade. This letter must be on school letterhead and must be signed by a school official.

GRADE DOCUMENTATION - PROTESTS

Coaches do <u>NOT</u> need to submit grade verification for their players to the MYAS prior to the tournament. However, they <u>MUST</u> have grade verification for all players with them at all times during the tournament. Failure to produce grade verification (see above) upon request may result in suspension of play and/or disqualification.

If a team files a protest and requests to see another team's grade documentation during the tournament, they must <u>FIRST</u> supply their own team's grade documentation and a \$100 cash protest fee to the MYAS Tournament Director. The protest fee will be returned if the protest is upheld.
